Milloy called the EPA's rule for fine particulate matter (PM 2.5) to tighten air quality standards "a backdoor way of regulating climate."

RAWSEP View:

The Inflation Reduction Act defines "air pollutants" including carbon dioxide as "greenhouse gases."

Some experts argue this legally authorizes the EPA to regulate greenhouse gases and encourage adopting renewable energy, while others were not so sure.

"There's no definition there, it's just sort of in a list, and it's casually mentioned," former Trump EPA transition team member Steve Milloy told the Daily Caller News Foundation. "There's no section that says carbon dioxide is an air pollutant under the Clean Air Act."

The Democrat-led climate bill signed into law Aug. 16 grew the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) authority over energy after the Supreme Court limited it in June, the bill's text shows, by defining carbon dioxide as an air pollutant. The court's decision in *West Virginia v. EPA* [limited](#) the EPA's regulatory power and found that Congress had not authorized the agency under the Clean Air Act (CAA) to impose greenhouse gas emissions caps under the now-replaced Clean Power Plan to force a national transition away from coal power. Several of the [Inflation Reduction Act](#)'s sections define the term "greenhouse gas" as "the air pollutants carbon dioxide, hydrofluorocarbons, methane, nitrous oxide, perfluorocarbons, and sulfur hexafluoride."

Democrats who contributed to the climate bill and legal experts said it clearly authorizes the EPA to regulate greenhouse gases and push for renewable energy adoption by defining fossil fuel-generated carbon dioxide as an "air pollutant" in an amended Clean Air Act, according to [The New York Times](#).

The language was opposed by Senate Republicans but survived their attempts to erase it, the outlet reported.

"[The EPA is] gonna try to use that as authorization that they can regulate carbon dioxide from coal plants because it has this [casual mention of carbon dioxide and air pollutant in the same sentence](#)," JunkScience.com founder and Trump EPA transition team member Steve Milloy told the Daily Caller News Foundation. "I don't think that that's gonna fly, ultimately, but a lot of damage can be done in the meantime. Because it's clear that there's no definition there, it's just sort of in a list, and it's casually mentioned. There's no section that says carbon dioxide is an air pollutant under the Clean Air Act."

Milloy called the EPA's rule for fine particulate matter (PM 2.5) to tighten air quality standards "a backdoor way of regulating climate."

"They'll probably do the same thing with ozone, and then they'll use this authority somehow," he said of the climate bill's language on carbon dioxide. ["EPA is gonna use every hook it thinks it has to crack down on greenhouse gas](#)

emissions. That’s why that definition was put in, because the Supreme Court said you need congressional authorization, and they don’t have any congressional authorization, not one. They have none, and that section doesn’t really give it to them, but they’re gonna pretend it does.”

Milloy said the “leftist” D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals might accept the Democrats’ argument. ([RELATED: Dems’ Climate Bill Includes Massive Tax Break For Mining Industry](#))

American Enterprise Institute Senior Fellow Benjamin Zycher told the DCF said it was unclear if language in the climate bill directing funds to dealing with carbon dioxide as a “pollutant” “satisfies the explicit delegation requirement for major questions as decided by the Supreme Court in West Virginia v. EPA.

“The argument that CO2 is an air pollutant under the traditional definition in the CAA is silly,” he said. “EPA is required under the CAA to promulgate an ambient air quality standard (AAQS) that ‘protects the public health’ with an ‘adequate margin of safety’ for an ‘air pollutant’ that EPA determines to be endangering the public health and safety. **EPA made that determination for CO2 in 2009; but that was and remains preposterous, as there is no evidence that increasing CO2 (or CO2-equivalent GHG) concentrations are ‘endangering’ anyone, or creating a ‘crisis.’**”

Brookings Institution Energy Security and Climate Initiative Director Samantha Gross tweeted, “I’m frustrated by voices on the right saying that Congress defining CO2 as a pollutant is an ‘end run’ around the recent WV v EPA Supreme Court decision. Congress sets laws, the courts interpret them. This is exactly what Congress is supposed to do!”

President Joe Biden signed the bill as **natural gas prices reached** their highest point in 14 years.

The EPA did not immediately respond to the DCF’s request for comment.

The Airthings View Plus can measure seven different aspects of your air quality, including [particulate matter 2.5 \(PM 2.5\)](#),

Particulate matter is any microscopic solids or liquids that can be inhaled. This often includes pollen, dust, smoke, vehicle emissions, mold spores, and even viral and bacterial particles.

The National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) notes that PM 2.5 — particles that are 2.5 microns across or smaller — are particularly troublesome. These are small enough to be inhaled and passed into the bloodstream.

Airthings View Pro - Design

The Airthings View Pro looks like many digital thermostats or carbon monoxide detectors. It can be set on a table or mounted to your wall via 3M Command Strips (included) or with screws (also included.)

It runs on six AA batteries but can also be powered via USB. If you choose to power it via USB, it can be used as a hub with other Airthings products.



You can choose which metrics are always displayed on the Airthings View Plus

On the front of the View Pro is a 2.9-inch ePaper display, used to show up to two of your preferred metrics.

Waving your hand in front of the View Pro will give you quick feedback on any areas of concern. For example, if your indoor air quality is good, it will display a smiley face and green light and read, "your air is good."

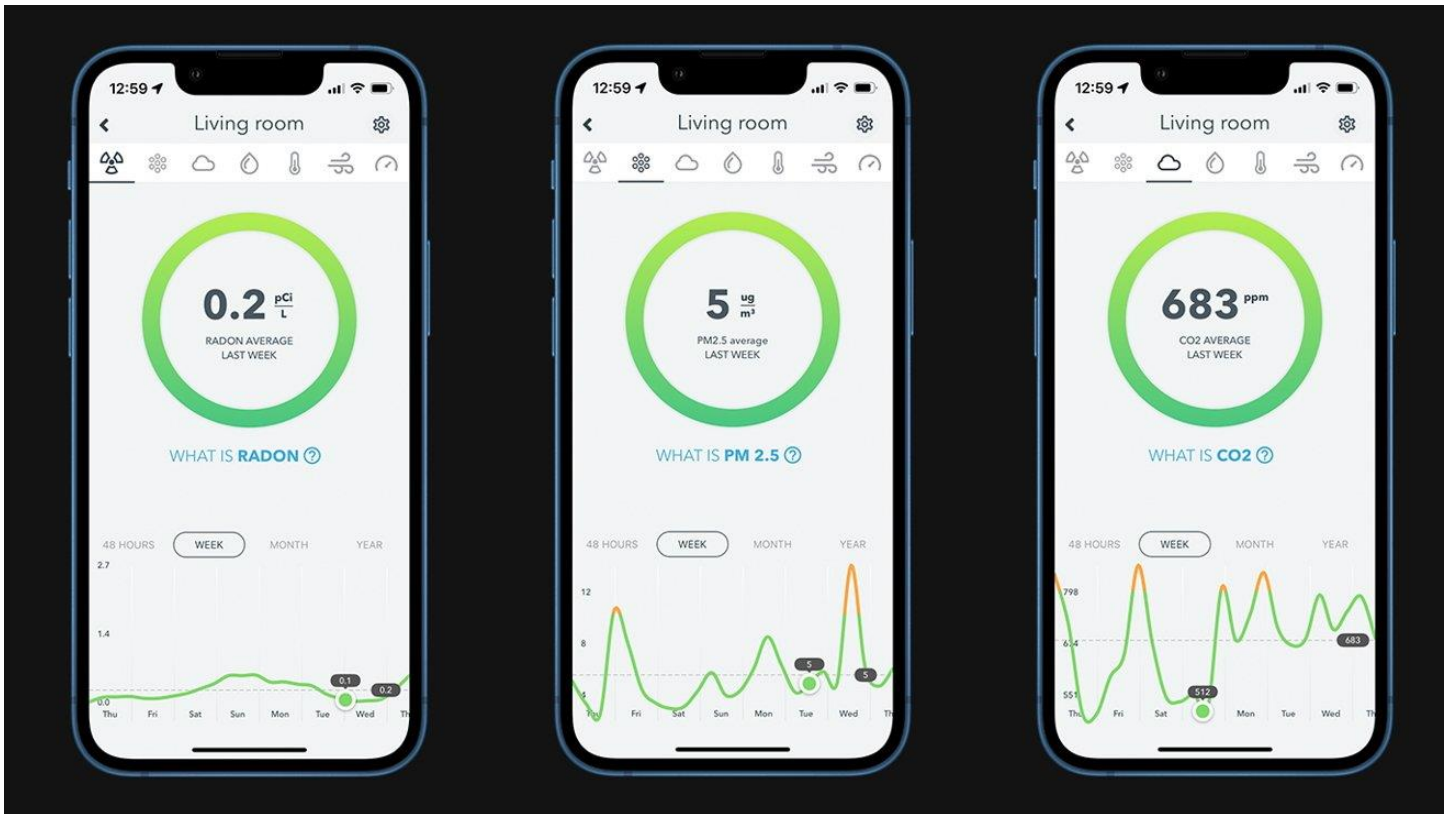
If your air quality readings dip outside the ranges that Airthings deems acceptable, it will display a yellow light for fair air quality or red light for poor air quality. It will also display the readings that may need to be addressed.

Overall, the design is decent. It's unobtrusive enough to blend into your home like thermostats and carbon monoxide detectors do. It's easy enough to use and provides some handy feedback.

Of course, one drawback to the ePaper display is that it's nearly impossible to read in dim lighting. However, that's the tradeoff for extended battery life, as the ePaper display uses significantly less energy than others.

Airthings View Pro - The app

While the display is nice, the real reason Airthings is valuable is because of the Airthings app. After you pair your Airthings with your home WiFi network, the Airthings app records the data from your Airthings devices and charts it over time.



Weekly readings for **particulate matter**

The app also allows you to pick one or two always-on metrics. You can also set up alerts that will tell you to take action when any air quality metric exceeds the requirement for poor air quality.

Rating: 4 out of 5
