While Delhi's air quality, on which mainstream media focuses, improved slightly, smaller towns--Ambala, Khanna, Kurukshetra and Ludhiana--had severely polluted air (AQI over 400) on November 9, according to the <u>air quality</u> index bulletin published by the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB).

But what does having an AQI over 400 really mean?

For one, it means that people are breathing air that has an average concentration of 250 micrograms of PM 2.5 per cubic metre ( $\mu g/m3$ ) in a day, according to the AQI-to-concentration converter. PM 2.5 refers to inhalable particulate matter that can enter the bloodstream and has several health impacts. A level of 250  $\mu g/m3$  is four times the permissible amount--60  $\mu g/m3$  over a 24-hour period--according to the standards defined by the CPCB.
