I don't know what "My own private Idaho is about" but I've always been amused by the film's title. Now, upon research, I can give you the film's synopsis, heavily edited by RAWSEP for a general audience. In this loose adaptation of Shakespeare's "Henry IV," Mike Waters (River Phoenix) is a young man afflicted with narcolepsy. Scott Favor (Keanu Reeves) is the rebellious son of a high local official. Together, the two travel from Portland, Oregon to Idaho and finally to the coast of Italy in a quest to find Mike's estranged mother The two eventually attract the attention of a wealthy benefactor.

Okay, so can I draw any analogies between my own private Wisconsin wood smoke and the film "My own private Idaho"? I sleep a lot. I am trying to get a local official to pass an ordinance regulating residential wood burning PM2.5 pollution, using PurpleAir PM2.5 monitors handed out to any near neighbor of a residential wood burner, if the near neighbor complains of E P A "unsafe" levels of PM2.5 entering the near neighbor's yard and infiltrating the near neighbor's house. I have recently traveled repeatedly to the local farmer's market to hand out flyers and stickers referring to this website in an attempt to attract the attention of other residents who are also experiencing unwanted pollution from residential wood burning, hoping that people will see and make the connection that the current Canadian wood smoke invading our fair city produces the same harm to human health as residential wood smoke. I live 70 feet from my neighbor's wood burning stove stack. A difference is that residential wood smoke is hyper-localized and unnoticed by others over about a few hundred feet from the residential wood burning. The Canadian wildfire smoke has traveled over 1,700 miles to reach Madison, Wisconsin, and its effects are quite noticeable. The local weather station has advised everyone to stay indoors as much as , for at the next two days, and wear a N95 mask if they have to go outside.


