PIT stands for Residential Wood Burners whose wood burning pollutes the air with PM2.5, particulate matter of 2.5 micrometer size. Emissions from residential wood burning enters the yards and infiltrates the homes of near neighbors. PM2.5 is the perfect size to infiltrate the human lung, setting off a cascade of human health problems and early deaths. YOU stands for the near neighbors who purchase or are given by the government, PM2.5 monitors which they keep on even overnight and on weekends, and whose data is published on PurpleAir online maps and on U S E P A maps of Smoke and Fire, alongside E P A \$100,000 regulatory monitors. B4 is the ideal situation of clean air, which existed before residential wood smoke invaded the yards of near neighbors. This Bingo Game can be played on a beach or in a home.

PIT-1 Wood smoke is more polluting than coal burning. PIT-2 Wood smoke is 90% PM2.5. PIT-3 Wood smoke particulate matter is 2.5 microns. PIT-4 Wood smoke PM2.5 infiltrates lungs. PIT-5 Wood smoke causes lung cancer. PIT-6 Wood smoke causes asthma, heart attacks, and strokes.

PIT-7 Wood smoke infiltrates yards of near neighbors. PIT-8 Wood smoke infiltrates homes of neighbors. PIT-9 Wood smoke is fought with air purifiers. PIT-10 Wood smoke is fought by staying indoors. PIT-11 Wood smoke is the same as Wildfire smoke.
