Question: What can people do to prevent the adverse impact of air pollution? Dr. Khilnani: People who have asthma and COPD, heart ailments, or are elderly should avoid going for a walk early in the morning when there is smog. As the Sun comes up, ‘inversion’ of the particulate matter happens and the gases rise up in the atmosphere making it safer for joggers. When we exercise, we breathe five times more the quantity of air than we do normally, and we tend to open our mouths obviating the nasal filter. So firstly, don’t exercise during early morning hours. The WHO Expert committee says that masks do not provide reliable protection against air pollution. For individuals susceptible to airborne ailments, an N95 mask can offer some usefulness, but there are more effective options such as ‘KN95’ or ‘N99’ masks. there is limited scientific evidence supporting the health benefits of air purifiers. they are of less benefit to healthy individuals and may be more useful for chronic patients. the World Health Organization (WHO) rejects claims of significant health benefits associated with air purifiers. Prof. G.C. Khilnani serves as the Chairman of the PSRI Institute of Pulmonary, Critical Care, and Sleep Medicine, bringing over 41 years of experience in the field. Prior to this role, he held the position of Head and Professor in the Department of Pulmonary Medicine and Sleep Disorders at AIIMS New Delhi.
