Near Neighbors of Indoor Residential Wood Burners, Book One.

Author's Note. The author conducted Epilepsy research for seven years and has a Bachelor of Science degree in Biochemistry. The author now works from home as a financial specialist, where the author is a near neighbor of an indoor residential wood burner. The wood burner's smoke (specifically PM2.5) enters the author's yard and sickens her. The author believes that basing solutions to air pollution on scientific fact, and pointing out the need for solutions based on medical statistics showing harm to human health, is the most efficient way of approaching and solving the problem of air pollution caused by indoor residential wood burning. The author also recognizes that indoor residential wood burning for home heating or for recreation creates more air pollution than any other form of home heating, and so indoor residential wood burning brings us closer to climate change than any alternative cleaner methods of home heating. Wood burning emits 90% PM2.5, particulate matter of 2.5 micrometer size, the perfect size to infiltrate the human lung, setting off a cascade of human health problems and early deaths. Wood burning emits more PM2.5 and Carbon Dioxide (CO₂) than the fossil fuel coal burning. Wood burning emits 450 times the PM2.5 as the fossil fuel natural gas burning.
