RAWSEP View This article shows possible Kamala Harris pathways to approach the problem of indoor residential wood burning air pollution that enters the yards of near neighbors and sickens them. Economic policy is the solution to the problem of indoor residential wood burning if it is true that indoor residential wood burners burn primarily because the wood burners are indigent and have no practical alternative to burning wood for home heating or to heat food. This article describes three economic solutions all presently written in pencil which is erasable. These projections of what could be economic solutions are not written with a pen. The Pen metaphor is the article writer's way of describing permanent government policy since Pen is generally not erasable. Is this discussion of pencil versus pen going to be part of future political discourse in America? Is Pencil versus Pen Economic Policies an idea that will capture the imagination of voters? Wait and see. In these pre article excerpt synopses RAWSEP will use the primary colors of the crayon to describe 2 non-traditional economic pathways which could be combined by Kamala Harris to solve the problem of air polluting indoor residential wood burning. Spend on housing and the accoutrements of clean housing such as offering rebates for Heat Pumps that work down to 40 degrees below zero and also function as Air Conditioners and which bring down existing electric bills immediately. The Rosy Red School of Thought argues for increasing the supply of essentials such as housing health care and clean energy using government making housing and clean energy less scarce and less costly in the first place. 1C The Blue School of Thought. Edited Excerpt from the article. But the Rosy Red School of Thought doesn't reflect how powerful interests hold parts of our economy captive. The modern antitrust movement and re-energized labor unions follow this school of thought. But this school of thought lacks affirmative answers on how to decarbonize quickly and at scale. 1D The Purple Vision of Vice President Kamala Harris which appears to be a blend of Rosy Red and Blue with a dash of remaining Gray. Vice President Kamala Harris's early proposals probably written in Pencil suggest she is drawing a new story as opposed to the traditional Gray view of letting the markets decide about how the economy works and the aims it should serve. Her slogan “We're not going back” might mean not going back to traditional economics. This new story has two themes which the New York Times writer calls 1D A “build” and 1E “balance.” 1D A The first theme of “build” focuses on pointing and shaping markets toward worthy aims. 1D E the second theme of “balance” corrects upstream power imbalances so that market outcomes are fairer and need less after the fact redistribution. 1D A Let's start with “build.” it literally means building things again rebuilding America's physical technology and energy infrastructure using trillions of dollars in public investment to stimulate private dollars and create good, unionized jobs. This is the heart of the Biden administration's legislative legacy. Vice President Kamala Harris deepens this

story in two ways. 1D A1 Housing. One economic pathway, is her plan to build more housing. She pledges three million new homes during her first term. 1D A2 People. But investing government money in people has been quashed in comparison to the government money allocated to building physical things. 1D A3 What Build means. Whether things or people Markets are a tool and our government's job is to shape markets. The New York Times writer then refers back to the Gray area of the past designated here as 1A Let Markets Rule should be edited with an eraser judiciously applied. While traditional markets are fine for many they can miss essentials like **decarbonization** a stable manufacturing base and **sufficient quantities of quality housing**. Decarbonization actions and housing building need to be organized and supplemented by active government policy. 1E is The Second part of what the New York Times writer thinks is Kamala Harris' economic vision for what America should be using what the writer calls "Balance". 1E markets left on their own tend to concentrate power resulting in fewer options higher prices less innovation and less control of our economic lives. It is the job of government to correct power imbalances whether they are 1E B power imbalances between bosses and workers 1E C power imbalances between finance and the rest of the economy 1E D power imbalances between big corporations and their smaller competitors and consumers or 1E E power imbalances between China's state driven economy and America. The focus needs to be more on helping U.S. allies to pull off versions of their own green and technology minded industrial policies. 1F RAWSEP Here applies the ideas of this article to an economic solution to the air pollution problem of indoor residential wood burning. 1F **RAWSEP View** 1F A Decarbonization and 1F B housing building should include laws that promote residential decarbonization and government funding for building clean energy home heating solutions into new housing. 1F A Decarbonization. Specifically this would be decarbonization of residential neighborhoods by passing laws either federal laws or state laws or local ordinances which use PurpleAir PM2.5 monitor data from monitors hanging from the eaves of near neighbors of indoor residential wood burners as evidence to shut down indoor residential wood burning using the PM2.5 monitor data which shows PM2.5 levels in the yards of near neighbors above Environmental Protection Agency National Ambient Air Quality Standards EPA NAAQS or above World Health Organization PM2.5 annual limits of 5 micrograms per cubic meter. 1F B Housing accompanied by clean energy home heating solutions. This specifically would mean that new housing would include Heat Pumps which work down to 40 degrees below zero and which double as air conditioners. These Heat Pumps would lower monthly heating bills immediately. 1 F C Correct a power imbalance. This decarbonization would correct the power imbalance between wood burning industry manufacturing selling and advertising and the health and lives of near neighbors of indoor residential wood burners whose PM2.5 wood smoke pollution enters the yards of near neighbors of indoor residential wood burners and sickens the near neighbors. The advertising of indoor residential wood stoves ignores the health and life denying effects of wood burning as well as the fact that wood burning brings us closer to climate change not farther away.
