You will see income limits for 80 percent of median income for Abbot Town, Maine. The 80 percent of median income

Limits for Abbot Town, Maine are \$46,500 for a one person household all the way up to \$87,000 for an 8 person household. Use these 80 percent of median income limits to see if you will receive the entire \$8,000 Heat Pump Rebate

because you are at or under the 80 percent of median income limit for your town, city, or county of your United State.

Here the income limit area for Abbot Town, Maine is Piscataquis County, Maine which has a median family income of \$66,600.

\* The FY 2014 Consolidated Appropriations Act changed the definition of extremely low-income to be the greater of 30/50ths (60 percent) of the Section 8 very low-income limit or the poverty guideline as [established by the Department of Health and Human Services \(HHS\)](#), provided that this amount is not greater than the Section 8 50% very low-income limit. Consequently, the extremely low income limits may equal the very low (50%) income limits.
