Prime Minister Keir Starmer's top team contains more lawmakers from poor backgrounds, and fewer from elite schools, than any in recent memory. Voters haven't noticed. Kamala Harris could point to the Inflation Reduction Act money allotted to Heat Pump Rebates as legislation for Heat Pump Rebates is just coming to fruition in United State rollouts in 2024 that heavily benefits the middle and working classes in America. Heat Pump Rebates are a kitchen table issue and will lower monthly electric heating bills immediately. Besides being an issue economically beneficial to the middle and working class, Heat Pump rebates are the logical clean energy alternative to indoor residential wood burning for home heating. Many people who burn wood indoors residentially depict themselves as indigent but do not even take advantage of existing federal and state home heating subsidies that could get them off the logistically irrational and increasingly expensive method of home heating by burning wood. The existing federal program that is administered by individual states is called Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program LIHEAP <https://www.acf.hhs.gov/ocs/programs/liheap> and is available for households based on a sliding income scale as the Heat Pump Rebates are or will shortly be available. In the meantime for those with immediate needs LIHEAP is there for low-income Americans. If indoor residential wood burners are being disingenuous to use a highfalutin term which means not **candid** or **sincere**, typically by **pretending** that one knows less about something than one really does, the typical indoor residential wood burner may not be indigent as claimed. If the indoor residential wood burner is merely middle class, lower middle class or working-class Heat Pump Rebates may be appealing to this United States taxpayer voter and all-around citizen. Rebate amounts are based on the number of persons in the household and the income of the household. If the household is at or below 80 percent of median income for the area in which the household lives in the full Heat Pump Rebate of up to \$8,000 can be applied for before buying a Heat Pump in a United State that is part of the program. Here is the website to check if your household is 80 percent of median income. Search it by your United State county or municipality and the 80 percent of median income based on number of persons in household can be read there at the Housing and Urban Development HUD website. <https://www.huduser.gov/portal/datasets/il.html> Will this offer of Heat Pump Rebates even available as a partial rebate to those households above 80 percent median income but not above 150 percent of median income appeal to the middle class, and working class? If this Rebate is publicized will it be viewed as a solution to a kitchen table issue? If Heat Pump Rebates are seized on and used by the general public in the United States will the replacement of indoor residential wood burning with the clean energy alternative of Heat Pumps help stop unnecessary air pollution from wood burning indoors residentially? Is it necessary to do more to stop indoor residential wood burning? Will the general public congratulate themselves on saving money for their households as well as contributing to cleaning the air, stopping increasing the risk of ill health and early death for their near neighbors as well as neighbors farther away in their airshed and contributing to slowing climate change? Only time will tell. Britain is also now serving as an example in beginning some legislation and enforcement of standards which may result in shutting down indoor residential wood burning one by one indoor residential wood burning stove at a time if necessary. To give the Conservative government some credit these policies began before July 2024 when Britain's national Labour government was elected but regulation of indoor residential wood burning may have been heavily promoted by Labour mayors such as the Mayor of London Sadiq Khan elected in 2016. Perhaps the shared misery of enduring air pollution that makes it hard to breathe transcended politics and caused the first steps of crackdown on the air pollution from indoor residential wood burning even during a Conservative administration.

Or the stark statistics that in the last few years the PM2.5 pollution from indoor residential wood burning emissions has surpassed PM2.5 pollution from traffic emissions in Britain. And the publicity that wood burning is done indoors residentially primarily as a fad a fashion and a folly by the British well to do. If stopping fuel subsidy payments to retirees were for stopping subsidies for wood fuel for home heating burning the Labour government made the right call. If retirees used Heat Pump Rebates to acquire Heat Pumps at little to no cost, there would be no fuel costs for retirees at all since Heat Pumps run only on electricity and using a Heat Pump lowers monthly electricity heating bills immediately. The new Labour government is also taking some steps that favor the middle and working classes in Britain in contrast to the previous Conservative government. Only time will tell if this is perceived by the middle and working class as beneficial in the long run. The British furor over freebies where no rules appear to have been broken seems to RAWSEP typical of what is often perceived as the distractingly gossipy non-issue nature of what is covered by the press in Britain. October 4, 2024. Hot water was a luxury in the home where the woman who is Britain's deputy prime minister was raised. The new British health secretary was born to a single mother who pawned her jewelry to make ends meet. Racist skinheads shouted abuse at the young Black Briton who is now the British foreign secretary near his home in a deprived part of north London. Britain's current cabinet including the prime minister, Keir Starmer is one of the most working class in Britain's history. Only one attended a private school and several spent their early lives in poverty. Mr. Starmer whose father worked in a factory has recounted when their phone was cut off because his parents couldn't pay the bills. Fewer than 25 percent of people in a recent poll see the Labour government, which came to power in July as caring about people like them, while almost 67 percent of voters see the new Labour government as not bothered by the interests of normal people. It was recently revealed that free gifts from party donors included clothing and eyeglasses for Mr. Starmer and dresses for Starmer's wife. Labour's landslide election victory in July led Conservatives to be banished to the opposition. 43 percent of Keir Starmer's cabinet come from working-class backgrounds, in that their parents had working class jobs. For the outgoing Conservative cabinet that was 7 percent. Nine top private schools including Eton have produced 67 percent of all prime ministers in Britain, despite the nine top private schools educating fewer than 2 tenths of one percent of all British schoolchildren. Only one member of Mr. Starmer's cabinet went to a private school which is the lowest number in British history. That contrasts with almost 67 percent of the cabinet under Rishi Sunak his predecessor attending private schools. The new Labour business and trade secretary whose father was a firefighter and whose mother worked for a door-to-door loans company said he was proud to be a part of the most working-class cabinet in British history. Although no rules appear to have been broken in the furor over freebies it possibly reinforces the impression that politicians of all political stripes are self-serving. Britain's right-leaning media leaped on the furor over freebies revelations. Many Conservative politicians pointedly refer to Keir Starmer as Sir Keir and his wife as Lady Victoria titles that Starmer and his wife rarely use. This has led some voters to believe wrongly that Starmer and his wife were aristocrats by birth. Mr. Starmer was given a knighthood in 2014 for serving as chief public prosecutor. On Wednesday, Downing Street said that Mr. Starmer had repaid more than 6,000 pounds almost \$7,900 to cover gifts he received since becoming prime minister, including the cost of Taylor Swift concert tickets. Three months after winning power the government has implemented few policies to help working people but angered many by curtailing fuel subsidy payments for retirees. Labour announced private schools tax exemption removal. Labour's first budget in October may contain more policies that appeal to the working class. A Conservative populist like Nigel Farage leader of the anti-immigration Reform U.K. party has cultivated an outsider's appeal to voters in struggling regions in Britain even though Farage attended an exclusive private school and worked as a commodity trader. Privileged Nigel Farage on this side of the Atlantic and privileged Donald Trump on the other side of the Atlantic ironically use outsider appeal to win support from voters to RAWSEP if this lack of endorsement of Kamala Harris by firefighters indicates that the very people who are called to stop fires are seemingly put off by the fact that the Democratic candidate for President is now a woman.
