After reviewing the research articles, this study suggested that PM_{2.5} exposure is strongly associated with Lung Cancer LUNG CANCER LC risk. Currently, the burden of LUNG CANCER LC is increasing worldwide, creating major public health issues. Previous studies were highly centered in China and the Global North; however, few studies have been conducted in the Global South. Several studies have demonstrated that pollution and LUNG CANCER LC risk are increasing globally. A study conducted by Schwartz et al. revealed that for every 5 micrograms per cubic meter increase in the PM_{2.5} concentration, the mortality rate 95% CI 4.67%, 6.08% increased by 5.37% in the USA. A study reported a 2% increase in mortality from respiratory disease for the same amount of PM_{2.5} concentration increase in Latin America. Both studies align with the findings of research conducted in Europe and Asia. It is not evenly distributed worldwide, with Asia having the highest concentration, which can result in serious health effects. PM_{2.5} was very high in African, Asian, and Latin American countries. However, they have received less attention in the global analysis of public health issues. Several epidemiological studies have indicated that PM exposure is closely associated with an increased risk of lung cancer. Spatiotemporal analysis is necessary for epidemiological research; if we ignore it, the research may lead to incorrect assessments. A few articles have explored the association between fine particulate matter and LUNG CANCER LC risk. Spatial and temporal analysis is important for pinpointing areas where disease cases cluster; it helps to explore whether these clusters are random, chance, or statistically significant, presenting evidence. Rozenfeld et al. used spatiotemporal analysis to explore the spatiotemporal variations in the impacts of COVID-19 associated with socioeconomic vulnerability, rapid population growth, and urbanization. During the review, studies employed either spatial or temporal epidemiological analysis methods, and a limited number of researchers explored both methods in their studies, which needs to be improved upon.
