Today stock market futures plummeted after President Donald J Trump announced that he will impose a 10% tariff on all imports to the United States with higher rates on about 60 countries he claims engage in unfair trade practices including China Japan Vietnam and South Korea as well as the European Union. Dow Jones Industrial Average futures lost more than 1000 points upon the news falling by 2.5% the S&P 500 dropped 3.6%. The Trump erratic approach to the economy had already rattled markets which dropped significantly in the first quarter of this year and consumer confidence which recently hit a twelve year low. Trump waited until the stock market had closed today before he announced the new tariffs. Never before has an hour of Presidential rhetoric cost so many people so much. Former treasury secretary Lawrence Summers posted The best estimate of the loss from tariff policy is now \$30 trillion or \$300000 per family of four. The Trump Tariff Tax is the largest peacetime tax hike in US history. posted former vice president Mike Pence. Senator Chris Murphy Democrat of Connecticut noted tonight that the tariffs make no economic sense because they are not designed as economic policy. The tariffs are simply a new super dangerous political tool. Murphy suggests they are a way to make private industry dependent on the president the same way he has tried to make law firms and universities dependent on him. Industries and companies will need to pledge loyalty to Trump in order to get sanctions relief. Murphy warns that the tariffs are DESIGNED to create economic hardship so that Trump has a straight face rationale for releasing them business by business or industry by industry. 4 Washington Colville Tribes and Ecology announce partnership to improve air quality [RAWSEP View](#) winter wood stove season is cited as one main reason for the need for air pollution mitigation [Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501c3 nonprofit organization](#) Washington State Department of Ecology WAgov wood burning stoves in the winter said Jarred Michael Erickson chairman of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation We are pleased OLYMPIA The Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation and the Washington Department of Ecology announced a new partnership that will reduce air pollution and improve overall health for those living on Tribal lands and in nearby communities The Colville Tribes and Ecology recently signed a memorandum of understanding that allows air quality managers to work together to monitor and mitigate air pollution This is especially important for tiny particles of smoke and soot called PM2.5 particle pollution less than 2.5 microns that can spike during summer wildfire season or winter wood stove season This work will help the Colville Tribes meet the requirements of the federal Clean Air Act and support the Tribal mandate to safeguard natural resources for future generations It will also help the state meet the direction from the Washington Climate Commitment Act to reduce air pollution Air pollution is not contained by a boundary on a map While the Colville Reservation is very rural we can still experience problems with poor air quality especially during fire season or from wood burning stoves in the winter said Jarred Michael Erickson chairman of the Confederated Tribes of the Colville Reservation We are pleased to partner with the Washington Department of Ecology to monitor air quality problems and to mitigate impacts of air pollution We all want to breathe clean air Improving air quality monitoring and developing programs to reduce air pollution will ultimately mean healthier communities said Ecology Director Casey Sixkiller I am excited about this partnership Sixkiller said It will make it easier for us to work together and to combine and expand our efforts to improve air quality It is a significant investment in cleaner air and that benefits everyone in the region Scope of work The partnership will allow the Ecology Air Quality program new access points to measure and monitor air quality in and around the sovereign lands of the Colville Tribes Better monitoring will help both the Colville Tribes and Washington meet federal air quality standards analyze regional trends in air pollution

and support communities where air pollution has impacted public health The Colville Tribes will also become eligible for various grant programs that can reduce the levels of criteria air pollutants like PM2.5

5 Wisconsin among states suing Trump administration over COVID era funding cancellations by United States Health and Human Services HHS [RAWSEP View](#) These Trump cuts to vaccination and tracking during the COVID pandemic and for future epidemic relief endanger Public Health [Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501c3 nonprofit organization](#) Milwaukee Journal Sentinel April 1 2025 Wisconsin joins a multi state lawsuit against the Trump administration over the cancellation of COVID 19 relief grants The lawsuit argues that the termination of these grants totaling billions of dollars nationwide was unlawful and arbitrary Wisconsin is one of nearly two dozen states suing Trump over the cancellation last week of COVID era grants that amount to more than \$225 million in funding Wisconsin had expected to yet receive The lawsuit which was filed Tuesday in the US District Court in Rhode Island argues the grant cancellations were unlawful and arbitrary and asks the federal court to block the cancellations The funding which was authorized by Congress as part of COVID 19 relief bills has been used for COVID specific purposes like vaccination and testing tracking other infectious diseases and more Much of the funding was not set to end until 2026 In notices sent to state health departments last week agencies within the US Department of Health and Human Services said the grants were no longer necessary and were being terminated for cause The COVID 19 pandemic is over the federal department said in a statement last week The lawsuit says HHS terminated \$11 billion in funding Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers again called the cuts reckless and pointed to the use of the funds for purposes beyond the COVID 19 pandemic itself These cuts will hurt the Wisconsin ability to respond to future public health emergencies

6 Wisconsin Retaliatory tariffs target Wisconsin top industries We are extremely concerned about the health and the future of our workforce The Department of Workforce Development DWD secretary says [RAWSEP View](#) These Trump tariffs endanger American jobs [Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501c3 nonprofit organization](#) National Public Radio March 21 2025 Wisconsin workers may be among the most at risk in the nation as other countries begin to impose retaliatory tariffs China Canada and the European Union plan to hit the two largest industries in Wisconsin agriculture and manufacturing with retaliatory tariffs The moves come in response to Trump tariffs on steel and aluminum and his broader threats and use of tariffs Almost 10 percent of Wisconsin jobs or nearly 300000 were in industries those countries are targeting That is the largest share of any state in the country manufacturing and agriculture are the Wisconsin top two industries Wisconsin agriculture accounts for around 353900 jobs annually while more than 460000 Wisconsinites work in manufacturing Both are particularly susceptible to retaliatory tariffs because they export a lot of goods across the globe Just last year the state exported \$263 billion worth of manufactured products Wisconsin also ranked as the 13th largest agricultural exporting state in the United States as of 2022 In response to Trump second term tariffs on Chinese goods China is imposing between 10 to 15 percent tariffs on American farm products and agricultural machinery Canada is applying 25 percent tariffs on a total of around \$60 billion worth of American goods as payback for the metal tariffs and threats of broader tariffs on Canadian goods according to the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation Canada is also holding back on plans for tariffs on another \$100 billion worth

of goods that could go into effect next month. And the European Union is planning countermeasures that could apply to \$286 billion worth of US goods which could be in force by mid April. Hiring slowdowns have already started. The trade war has left many businesses looking at significantly reduced profit margins. Tariffs on imports make it more expensive for them to buy parts from overseas while the duties of other countries on American exports make it harder to sell products globally. Tariffs may have already had a chilling effect on the economy with hiring nationally down by 10 percent from last year. While they have not taken effect yet the planned tariffs of the European Union could affect Milwaukee based Harley Davidson an iconic American company. The EU listed motorcycles on the list of possible products it could target. Sales in the Europe Middle East and Africa market accounted for nearly 17 percent of Harley sales in 2023. It was the second biggest market of Harley behind US sales which accounted for 60 percent. The Wisconsin agricultural economy saw over 3 Billion dollars in exports last year. Wisconsin farmers exported millions of dollars in products to 58 countries in 2024 the report said. Wisconsin food processors exported billions worth of products to 133 countries with dairy products accounting for millions of those processed exports. Canada was the largest buyer of Wisconsin food processing products last year buying billions worth of goods. Canada our neighbors to the north are imposing 25 percent tariffs on fresh fruit dairy products poultry and rice. Likewise China has placed tariffs on American chicken wheat corn cotton soybeans pork beef fruits vegetables and dairy products. Europe also included milk cream poultry and meat products on its list of products it may tariff.

A crowd of about 500 people students researchers cancer survivors and other stakeholders applauded chanted and held up signs at the Wisconsin State Capitol Friday in support of the academic research under the microscope in Washington DC. At the Stand Up for Science rally people gathered to hear testimony about the value of scientific research in an effort to convince federal lawmakers to reject the Trump proposed cutbacks to government sponsored research grants. The rally was one of 50 demonstrations planned nationwide in response to recent executive orders that have dramatically reduced the funds available to perform ongoing research projects including a significant reduction of F&A facilities and administration costs that are associated with performing contracted research. Each of the speakers issued a call to action for attendees to contact their elected representatives and otherwise get behind a nationwide effort to restore the funding. University of Wisconsin Madison professor a biochemist and the lead organizer of the Friday rally said the state of Wisconsin stands to lose \$15 million per week in National Institutes of Health NIH sponsored research dollars. He said the cuts would undermine American economic competitiveness at a time when China our chief global competitor is ramping up its investments in fundamental research. Investment in academic research is a federal policy that dates back 80 years and it developed with bipartisan support. It was a fundamental decision during World War II when at the direction of President Franklin Roosevelt. It is our core strategic advantage as a nation and it is the fundamental driver of our economy.
