The city is suing oil companies over global warming Trump says lawsuits like these threaten national security The judge wants to hear what both sides think [RAWSEP View](#) The courts may return the United States to its previous Biden Era economic prosperity See the excerpt below about the court block of Trump Tariffs this week In addition if courts block Trump prevention of state suits against fossil fuel companies for contributing to climate change the resulting monetary judgements against fossil fuel companies may be used to launch effective fights against climate change and possibly fund clean energy efforts which fund further clean solar and wind energy projects [Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501c3 nonprofit organization](#) The New York Times May 29 2025 Charleston is vulnerable to climate change The sea level nearby has risen a foot So Charleston sued The city is one of states and local communities suing the biggest oil companies in the world But the case is unusual Charleston has a new Republican mayor who let the lawsuit proceed South Carolina also Republican controlled opposes the lawsuit This week the case faces a major test On Thursday and Friday lawyers for Charleston and the oil companies are scheduled to face off in state court A Trump executive order in April called lawsuits like these a threat to national security Trump launched a new attack against climate lawsuits The Trump Justice Department preemptively sued Hawaii and Michigan to try to prevent them from even filing suits of their own The judge in the Charleston case will hear arguments about whether it deserves to proceed to trial He has also asked each side to weigh in on the implications of the Trump executive order In a letter to the court last week the lawyer representing Chevron also argued that the court should look to the May 16 dismissal of a climate change lawsuit in Bucks County Pennsylvania The judge there wrote that the court was joining a growing chorus of state and federal courts across the United States singing from the same hymnal in deciding that the claims could not be adjudicated in a state court But the lawyer who represents Charleston and many of the other state and local governments that have filed similar suits countered that Trump argument in a response to the court He called the Bucks County ruling an erroneous decision that contains no original legal analysis and added that the court had neglected to mention that the Supreme Courts of Hawaii and Colorado have upheld lower court decisions allowing similar cases there to proceed

Employees of Elon Musk department of government efficiency Doge own lucrative stock in companies that stand to directly benefit from their work gutting federal agencies Democratic senators have alleged The potential ethics violations merit an investigation by the justice department and other oversight bodies urges a letter co authored by senators Elizabeth Warren of Massachusetts Ron Wyden of Oregon and Jack Reed of Rhode Island and obtained by the Guardian We write regarding new reports that Doge employees at the treasury Internal Revenue Service IRS and the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau CFPB have been engaged in the dismantling of these agencies while holding hundreds of thousands of dollars of stock in private companies benefitting from these efforts of individuals to eliminate key programs staff and policies the senators state Together three examples underscore what appears to be a pervasive problem with Elon Musk and Doge employees trampling ethics rules and laws to benefit their own pockets at the expense of the American public The letter explicitly calls for a broad review by the inspectors general regarding illegal or inappropriate efforts and an investigation by the justice department into whether these and other Doge representatives may have violated federal ethics law by abusing their official roles for the benefit of private companies in which they have a vested financial interest

11 Your Cat May or May Not Love You but It Knows Your Scent **RAWSEP View** This study showed that a research protocol could be designed that cats would voluntarily participate in This groundbreaking study also indicated that scents of strangers were explored by the cat right nostril and familiar scents were explored by the cat left nostril **RAWSEP concludes** that perhaps this knowledge could result in better care for cats by their owners **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501c3 nonprofit organization** The New York Times or the New York Times Translation May 28 2025 For animals that are warm and fuzzy cats have a penchant for independence or even aloofness They tend to have their own ideas about what they should be doing which may or may not align with the wishes of their owners The independent natures of cats may be a factor in why research into their behavior has lagged behind scientific explorations into those of other domesticated animals including dogs In reality cats understand many things as well as dogs do but they do not show it in their behavior and are more guarded which makes it difficult to conduct experiments said a professor of animal science at the Tokyo University of Agriculture But in a study published on Wednesday in the journal PLOS One Doctor Uchiyama and his team managed to achieve some research findings in feline behavior establishing that cats respond differently to the scents of their owners than to the odors of strangers That suggests your feline friend knows what you smell like in addition to what you look and sound like Through referrals from friends and colleagues the researchers recruited 30 cats and their owners to participate in the study The owners of the cats captured their own scents by rubbing cotton swabs behind their ears between their toes and under their armpits Eight additional people who do not own pets and did not know the owners of the cats were recruited to be odor donors Each of the study cats in the comfort of its own home was then presented with an array of test tubes containing the smelly cotton swabs from its owner a stranger and a blank control A camera mounted to the experimental setup recorded the reactions of the cats to the test tubes The cats spent more time sniffing the samples from the strangers than from their owners an indication that the cats could recognize the scents of their owners and devoted more time to exploring the ones they had never smelled before While this finding might seem like common sense it is a very important piece of information said an associate professor of animal behavior at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine This is how science works You need to prove everything The researcher and his colleagues further analyzed video recordings of the cats sniffing the test tubes and observed the cats

predominantly using their right nostrils to smell the test tubes of strangers regardless of where the tube was placed within the array. These findings seemed to corroborate previous studies of other animals including dogs which also led with their right nostrils when exploring strange scents. The left nostril is used for familiar odors and the right nostril is used for new and alarming odors suggesting that scenting may be related to how the brain functions. It is likely that the right brain is preferred for processing emotionally alarming odors. The researcher urged caution in interpreting whether the sniffing behavior of the cats relates to brain function. The study did not prove that the right side of the brain is activated he said. Proving that will require cats willing to cooperate with having their brains scanned while they sniff things. Further research is needed to confirm whether the nostril cats use to smell people is a window into the feline mind. Studies like this are important for furthering human understanding of feline behavior which can help us provide better care for them. This research also showed that a cat study protocol could be deemed acceptable by its feline participants. I really commend this group of scientists for being successful in engaging 30 cats in doing this stuff the researcher said. Most cats want nothing to do with your research.

Better even than our parents whose revolts in the late 1960s rarely led to any serious reckoning with the legacy of the Holocaust. Born in the late 1980s my generation learned about Auschwitz early on. We visited former concentration camps and studied the Nazi regime not as an alien aberration but as a warning this is how democracies die. 14 Robert F Kennedy Junior RFK Junior threatens ban on federal scientists publishing in top journals US health secretary calls leading medical journals such as Lancet corrupt and pushes to create state run alternatives [RAWSEP View](#) Kennedy Junior is not a scientist or a doctor and his views are consistently anti science and anti modern medicine Kennedy Junior has a conflict of interest from receiving money from pharmaceutical companies for anti science and anti medicine research studies himself Kennedy Junior seems to be taking tactics from the Trump playbook of projection of guilt which Trump himself exhibits onto others who are innocent of that particular brand of Trump corruption Kennedy Junior projects corruption accusations against others when the corruption is originating in the actual actions of Kennedy Junior himself Limiting knowledge of medical and scientific studies published in scientific journals limits scientific knowledge itself to the detriment of modern medicine and to the detriment of human health itself Follow the money and see how Kennedy Junior has been enriched by pharmaceutical companies for anti science research [Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501c3 nonprofit organization](#) The Guardian May 28 2025 Robert F Kennedy Junior has threatened to ban government scientists from publishing in the leading medical journals of the world which he branded corrupt and to instead create alternative publications run by the state We are probably going to stop publishing in the Lancet New England Journal of Medicine Jama and those other journals because they are all corrupt the US health secretary said on the Ultimate Human podcast He accused the publications of being controlled by pharmaceutical companies Instead Kennedy outlined plans to launch government run journals that would become the preeminent journals because National Institutes of Health funding would anoint researchers as a good legitimate scientist The three publications Kennedy targeted are among the most influential medical journals globally established in the 19th century and now central to disseminating peer reviewed medical research worldwide The Lancet and Jama each report more than 30m annual website visits while the New England Journal of Medicine claims more than 1 million weekly readers Kennedy has similarly accused the agencies he now oversees – including the NIH Centers for Disease Control and Prevention Food and Drug Administration and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services – as sock puppets for the pharmaceutical industry The second Trump administration has taken an axe to scientific research with NIH funding cut by more than \$3 billion since the year before Kennedy has also purged an estimated 20000 health department staff from the government In contrast a public health researcher at Harvard Medical School is quoted as saying Banning NIH funded researchers from publishing in leading medical journals and requiring them to publish only in journals that carry the RFK Junior seal of approval would delegitimize taxpayer funded research The comments of the health secretary followed the release of a White House report last week that challenged medical consensus on vaccines and suggested pharmaceutical influence has prevented proper study of chronic disease causes in children The Kennedy Junior funding cuts and personnel changes have prompted some US scientists to consider relocating abroad with countries including France Germany Spain and China actively recruiting American researchers

professors literary scholars social theorists and critics of culture are the ones who speak truth to power and fight back against oppression Yet scientists also ought to stand up and organize against the Trump attacks on scientific research and integrity History is replete with examples of scientists that have taken on great risks to resist authoritarianism Scientific inquiry cannot flourish in a society dominated by fear censorship and hate Most Scientists have an underlying goal of advancing humanity whether that is by finding cures to disease new technology or pushing the boundaries of human knowledge so that future generations are better off All of that is at risk if we remain neutral or apolitical at the wrong moment in history where there is an apparent slide toward fascism Our scientific research itself must remain free from prejudice and aimed wherever the truth may lead but the work before us is not only scientific research We must also work to preserve the conditions of life that make both science and society flourish

If the answer is yes try to tackle your behavior in the moment instead You might acknowledge your mood and say you are going to reset You could even half jokingly ask the other person to help you out by giving you an update on their news while you are rebooting Better still take a few minutes before a meet up to focus on your positive relationship with the person and what might be going on in their life Ultimately the best way to get out of your own head is to consider the needs of another person

I have spoken about the proposed incinerator before in this chamber, but I am raising it again today because it is incredibly important to the community that I represent. I am proud to stand with the community as they continue to fight against this.

The Lara community has some very reasonable concerns about this project, and these are concerns that I share. These include safety issues; the proximity of the proposed incinerator to local homes, schools and businesses; and the impact that it will have on air quality and noise pollution in the area.

This project has no social licence.

There have been hundreds of written objections lodged throughout the planning process, with hundreds of community members attending forums and thousands who have signed a petition to object.
