Cartoon 1 of 4 Title The Trial of Slobodan Milošević How to bring down a dictator Cell 1 Milošević was the first post-World War II head of state tried by an international criminal tribunal Cell 2 The Milošević trial marked a pivotal moment in international law Cell 3 The trial opened with accusations of conducting extremely brutal wars in Kosovo Croatia and Bosnia Cell 4 Unfortunately Milošević died in March 2006 just months before the trial concluded leaving many aspects of the case unresolved
