2 RFK Junior Whistleblowing Successor to Doctor Fauci fired by RFK Junior **RAWSEP View** This is reminiscent of the firing of the CDC Chief Doctor Susan Monarez in September 2025 Doctor Jeanne Marrazzo alleged that RFK Junior undermined scientific vaccine research at the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases where she was director as successor to Doctor Anthony Fauci **Successor to Anthony Fauci fired Doctor Jeanne Marrazzo fired Kennedy Fires National Institutes of Health N I H Scientist Who Filed Whistle Blower Complaint** **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** The New York Times October 2 2025 Doctor Jeanne Marrazzo alleged that the Trump administration had defied court orders and undermined vaccine research Doctor Jeanne Marrazzo former director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases testified before the Senate last year Three weeks after a leading scientist at the National Institutes of Health filed a whistle blower complaint against the Trump administration Health Secretary RFK Junior fired her according to her lawyer and a copy of the termination letter Her dismissal was the **latest in a series of steps the Trump administration has taken against government scientists and environmental experts after they warned that administration policies were endangering public health and safety** In her complaint the scientist Doctor Jeanne Marrazzo who had directed the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases objected to Trump administration actions alleging that they had **endangered research subjects defied court orders and undermined vaccine research** After Doctor Marrazzo raised concerns internally earlier this year the complaint said she was placed on involuntary administrative leave though not fired Doctor Marrazzo said on Thursday that she received notice of her firing from RFK Junior this week in a letter dated September 26 The health secretary wrote that he had the authority to appoint directors of N I H Accordingly RFK Junior went on in my capacity as secretary I have decided to terminate your

appointment as the director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Disease. A woman lawyer for Doctor Marrazzo said in a statement that the firing was retaliatory. **The Trump Administration terminated Doctor Marrazzo for her advocacy on behalf of critical health research and for her support of the overwhelming body of evidence that shows vaccines are safe and effective** her woman lawyer said. **The firing of the federal government onetime chief of infectious disease research further thinned the ranks of vaccine and infectious disease scientists working under President Trump.** Several senior officials at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention including the directors of centers that managed emerging diseases respiratory illnesses and vaccine recommendations resigned in late August after its director **Susan Monarez was dismissed.** The Trump administration has also clamped down on government scientists and environmental experts who have raised alarms in recent months about new policies. The Environmental Protection Agency and the Federal Emergency Management Agency each suspended employees for criticizing the Trump administration. The National Institutes of Health N I H director Doctor Jay Bhattacharya has pledged to welcome conflicting views. But that agency too retaliated against Doctor Marrazzo for protected whistle blower activity her woman lawyer said. Doctor Marrazzo filed her whistle blower complaint last month alongside Doctor Kathleen Neuzil then the director of the N I H Fogarty International Center which supports global health research. Doctor Neuzil too said in the complaint that she had been removed from her role and placed on involuntary administrative **leave after objecting to what she described as dangerous and unscientific views about vaccines taking hold in the upper echelons of the N I H.** It had long been one of the world leading engines of vaccine research. Shortly before filing the whistle blower complaint Doctor Neuzil resigned in what she said was a departure forced by the N I H decision to not give her any work. **She was recently hired as the director of polio eradication efforts at the Gates Foundation.** In response to the whistle blower complaint last month the Health Department dismissed the allegations by Doctor Marrazzo and Doctor Neuzil that the Trump RFK Junior N I H policies were unscientific. Assertions that reprioritization reallocation or cancellation of certain grants are against science misrepresent N I H progress and often echo the grievances of former staff Andrew Nixon a Health Department spokesman said. Doctor Marrazzo was left with no real avenues of recourse in the aftermath of her firing given that the Trump administration had eviscerated the government agency that protects whistle blowers her woman lawyer said. In a statement Doctor Marrazzo urged Congress to act. My termination unfortunately shows that the leaders of Health and Human Services HHS and the National Institutes of Health N I H do not share my commitment to scientific integrity and public health Doctor Marrazzo said. The New York Times October 2 2025 The Energy Department said on Wednesday night that it would cancel more than 7 point 5 billion dollars in Biden administration awards for hundreds of energy projects with the majority located in states led by Democrats Trump appeared to be using the government shutdown as a pretext to punish political opponents Trump said this week that if Democrats in Congress did not vote for a funding bill to keep the government open he would do things during the shutdown that are irreversible that are bad for them According to an Energy agency document the affected projects include major upgrades to electrical grids in California Minnesota and Oregon The majority of the 321 canceled awards would have gone toward projects in those 3 states as well as Connecticut Delaware Hawaii Illinois Massachusetts Maryland New Mexico New York and Washington Those states all have Democratic governors and senators Republican held states and districts were not entirely spared The Pacific Northwest hydrogen hub was expected to create jobs in Montana Some of the cuts would affect projects in states like Florida South Carolina and Texas where a battery factory was being built with help from a \$20 million federal grant that is now being canceled Financial awards for two dozen projects to upgrade electrical grids in America were also targeted for termination That includes \$630 million to help upgrade 100 miles of transmission lines in California with advanced conductors that can carry more electrical current as well as a 250 million dollar grant to strengthen power lines in central Oregon Also targeted for cancellation was a 464 million dollar grant awarded to Minnesota to help improve the connections between two large regional electrical grids in the Midwest and Great Plains aimed at making it easier to add more renewable energy to the grid and reducing the risk of blackouts Proponents said it would have helped reduce electricity costs across a wide region including in Republican led states
