Yes 3 Electric Vehicles How Much It Costs to Drive an EV and a Gas Car in Every State 4 Trump Actions [RAWSEP View](#) Lack of Scientific Basis for Sharpie Meteorology Decisions by Trump [From the article headline](#) Senate Confirms Neil Jacobs Sharpie gate Meteorologist to Lead NOAA The New York Times Headlines Main Content 1 RFK Junior Vaccine Denial Parents Struggle to Find Covid Vaccines for Their Children Amid Regulatory Confusion The New York Times Seeking Covid Shots for Their Children Some Parents Hit a Wall Children under 12 need different versions of Covid vaccine but many pharmacies and offices of pediatricians are not stocking them [Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization](#) The New York Times October 7 2025 The decisions of public health agencies under Trump and his health secretary RFK Junior have created new obstacles for many people seeking Covid vaccines It has been particularly difficult to secure shots for children including infants and toddlers under the age of 2 who are at higher risk of severe illness from Covid even if they are healthy In August the Food and Drug Administration FDA limited approval of the latest Covid shots authorizing them only for adults 65 and older and younger people with certain health conditions A few weeks later a vaccine advisory panel ACIP for the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention CDC released its own guidance saying that anyone 6 months and up could get the vaccine in consultation with a medical provider [Children under 12 need a different version of the Covid vaccines](#) The FDA limited its approval of the Pfizer vaccine to ages 5 and up which left the Moderna vaccine as the only option for younger children Representatives for Moderna and Pfizer said their companies had enough doses to meet demand But some providers have told parents that they did not place orders because of the regulatory confusion Some were waiting for formal approval of the vaccine panel recommendations by the interim CDC leader which was announced Monday October 6 2025 about two weeks after the ACIP panel had voted Others stocked the Pfizer [pediatric doses](#) in past years and are [scrambling to determine the feasibility of a new contract with Moderna](#) Two parents said their pediatricians had [cited the need to switch to Moderna as one reason they did not have Covid vaccines for children under 5](#) The chair of the American Academy of Pediatrics AAP committee on infectious diseases said he had heard the same from providers The AAP recommends Covid vaccination for children under 2 regardless of their overall health status It also recommends the shot for older children who have high risk conditions those in close contact with high risk people and those who have not received a Covid vaccine before The AAP says the shot should be available to any child whose parents want it The CDC panel recommendations called for doctors to change how they obtain informed consent and to discuss the risks and benefits of vaccines with patients but did not specify how Because the FDA limited its approval to people who are 65 and older or who have a high risk condition [many of the Covid vaccinations they would administer would be off label](#) [Doctors have the legal authority to prescribe off label but some are uneasy about it](#) Regardless of FDA and CDC decisions some states have higher minimum ages than others for pharmacists to vaccinate with variation depending on the vaccine In New York pharmacists can currently give Covid shots to children 3 and older which makes access exceedingly difficult for the high risk under 2 group if their pediatricians do not stock the vaccine A representative for CVS said select CVS pharmacies nationwide had Covid vaccines available for children

5 and up She added that all Minute Clinics medical facilities inside some CVS stores that have more regulatory freedom than pharmacies were vaccinating children 18 months and older **Only about 10 percent of CVS locations have a Minute Clinic** Walgreens and Walmart did not respond to inquiries about pediatric vaccine availability and a Costco representative said only that parents should continue to visit our website and check the Costco schedule for availability But many parents are trawling websites calling and showing up to every provider they can think of Some have succeeded in finding shots only after weeks of persistence 2 Canada **RAWSEP View** Did the nasty comment come from Trump? Yes **From the article** Trump did describe Mister Carney a former central bank chief for England and Canada as a nice man who could be very nasty While the Trump calls for US annexation of Canada and Trump tariffs angered many Canadians and prompted boycotts of American products and travel to the United States Mister Carney praised Trump before the meeting and called him a transformative president **From the article headline** Carney and Trump A Collision Avoided Save for a Nasty Comment or Two The New York Times During a meeting with Prime Minister Mark Carney of Canada on Tuesday President Trump told reporters that the people of Canada will love us again even if some American imposed tariffs remained in place which he insisted they would **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** The New York Times October 7 2025 Prime Minister Mark Carney of Canada arrived at the White House on Tuesday with a few clear objectives to take heat out of his early encounters with President Trump and begin talks on steel and aluminum tariffs and keep their disputes on dairy products softwood lumber and automobiles on a separate track Afterwards Canadian officials said they now expected to make progress on steel aluminum and energy levies which range up to 50 percent The two leaders ordered their officials to come to a deal on aluminum and steel tariffs as soon as possible Trump declined however to offer a time estimate Mister Carney came to office in April following a campaign in which he portrayed himself as a hardliner the best and toughest candidate to take on Trump Unlike many other nations Canada has not been able to strike a trade deal with Trump and that had put pressure on Mister Carney to try to win at least some tariff relief during the meeting Trump has imposed a general 35 percent tariff on Canadian exports based on his claim which is refuted by data that Canada is a significant source of migrants and fentanyl for the United States That broad tariff does have a significant exemption It excludes products that qualify as North American under the free trade agreement signed by Canada the United States and Mexico during the Trump first term which make up a majority of Canadian exports But Trump has imposed tariffs on several key exports from Canada automobiles steel aluminum and most recently softwood lumber calling the measures a matter of national security Those tariffs have already had significant effects General Motors is planning to cut a shift at its pickup truck factory in Oshawa Ontario Canada jeopardizing about 2 000 jobs In the same province of Ontario Canada Stellantis suspended the overhauling of a factory in Brampton to produce a new Jeep model leaving the plant idle Canada has set aside 10 billion Canadian dollars or 7 point 1 billion US dollars in loans for large steel and aluminum companies affected by the US tariffs Mister Carney reminded Trump that Canada imported about as many cars made in the United States as it sent there as well as the two way flow in steel Recent concessions from Mister Carney include lifting most of the reciprocal tariffs Canada had put on goods from the United States except those applied to the same products covered by the Trump national security tariffs Mister Carney also canceled a tax on American tech companies he had inherited from the previous
