combinations thereof Under current trends air quality is projected to improve by 2050 nevertheless the absolute attributable burden of ischemic heart disease stroke and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease remains high in many regions Cleaner cooking fuel use is effective in the short term by 2030 in South and Central America Asia and Africa for reducing PM 2 POINT 5 related deaths In the long term by 2050 for most regions only strategies that simultaneously target ambient and cooking related PM 2 POINT 5 resulted in sustained improvements that expand beyond current trends for reducing disease burden across these three health outcomes In the Asian region for example under current trends the population attributable fraction decreases from 35 percent in 2015 to 18 percent in 2050 In the scenario combining universal clean cooking and climate policy it drops further to 15 percent and when all strategies are combined it reaches as low as 11 percent by 2050 With all strategies combined the average global population weighted PM 2 POINT 5 exposure from both ambient and cooking sources is reduced by nearly two thirds 66 micrograms per cubic meter compared with 26 micrograms per cubic meter For North Africa and the Middle East region the population attributable fraction remains high across all scenarios Additional strategies beyond those mentioned here are required to further improve air quality It is recommended to pursue climate mitigation alongside universal access to cleaner household fuels to maximize cardiopulmonary health benefits
