Shortly before his segment aired on the East Coast he announced on his campaign website that he was entering the race vowing to be the fighter and protector of California I am running for governor because prices are too high and people are scared he said on his website Swalwell explained that he would keep the worst president in history out of our homes out of our streets and out of our lives He also said that he would focus on homes and jobs as governor Swalwell is likely to emphasize his history of fighting Trump an approach that many Democratic voters say they want their elected officials to take He has spent a dozen years representing a suburban district east of San Francisco in Congress before which he served as a city councilman in Dublin California He is a former prosecutor who often talks about his father and brothers working as police officers In Washington Swalwell has held high profile positions on the House intelligence and judiciary committees where he helped investigate evidence for The Trump first impeachment in 2019 After the Jan 6 2021 attack on the Capitol Swalwell was named a manager of The Trump second impeachment Earlier this month Bill Pulte the director of the Federal Housing Finance Agency under Trump accused Swalwell of having committed mortgage and tax fraud by obtaining several million dollars of home loans The allegation was similar to one the Trump administration lodged against Senator Adam Schiff another California Democrat who as a House member helped manage the first impeachment case against Trump Swalwell not only denied the fraud accusation but also seemed to wear it as a badge of honor issuing a statement suggesting that it was payback for having been the most vocal critic of Trump over the last decade Voters are on edge about the high cost of living in the state with four in 10 saying in a recent survey that they were concerned about not having enough money to pay their rent or mortgage

Lost Science is an ongoing series of accounts from scientists who have lost their jobs or funding after cuts by the Trump administration. I had a grant from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to identify the relationships between heat, pollution, and the health of children in New York State. New York State includes the most and least populated areas in the country, like Manhattan and the Adirondacks. Instead of looking at things that can cause stress, like income inequality, and how those can make the effects of heat and pollution worse, we were trying to identify the resources in communities where children appear to be less affected by heat and pollution. This information can help identify the most cost-effective changes communities can make to protect their children. We combined data on 22 million child emergency department visits and hospitalizations with US census information. We also considered a wide range of community factors not included in those data sets, everything from supermarket locations, transportation access, voter registration, and broadband access. A researcher reached out to 350 school districts in the state. So a lot of groundwork was done to build up a really complicated and huge database that represented a massive number of children statewide. It was a three-year

grant but it built on research that we had been developing for over 15 years **Our early results showed that days with high air pollution and extreme temperatures did have more child emergency department visits** On May 12 I received an email saying our project was to be terminated immediately There was no warning no conversation At the time we were in the final stages of being able to combine our data to answer the critical question **Which community investments really matter and how can they help children be more resilient to pollution and heat?** The next step would have been to finish analyzing the data but we were not able to get that far We appealed the cancellation and got a response stating that the project was not within the scope of the current E P A The administration has decided to close the entire division supporting this grant the Office of Research and Development It was funding the work of my lab in environmental health science An abrupt cancellation means that we will never get the payoff from so much upfront investment It is a devastating time for labs many of which are shutting down Familiarity needed to work with data sets as large as ours is not expertise that can be easily replaced

9 RFK Junior Lack of knowledge of science and medicine CDC website is changed to raise suspicions of a vaccines autism link AP News **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** A Centers for Disease Control and Prevention website has been changed to contradict the longtime scientific conclusion that vaccines do not cause autism spurring outrage among a number of public health and autism experts The CDC vaccine safety webpage was updated Wednesday saying the statement Vaccines do not cause autism is not an evidence based claim The change is the latest move by the US Department of Health and Human Services to revisit and foster uncertainty about long held scientific consensus about the safety of vaccines and other pharmaceutical products It was immediately decried by scientists and advocates who have long been focused on finding the causes of autism We are appalled to find that the content on the CDC webpage Autism and Vaccines has been changed and distorted and is now filled with rhetoric against vaccines and outright lies about vaccines and autism the Autism Science Foundation said in a statement Thursday Widespread scientific consensus and decades of studies have firmly concluded there is no link between vaccines and autism The conclusion is clear and unambiguous said Dr Susan Kressly president of the American Academy of Pediatrics in a statement Thursday We call on the CDC to stop wasting government resources to amplify false claims that sow doubt in one of the best tools we have to keep children healthy and thriving routine immunizations she said The CDC has until now echoed the absence of a link in promoting Food and Drug Administration licensed vaccines But anti vaccines activists including RFK Junior who this year became secretary of Health and Human Services have long claimed there is one It is unclear if anyone at CDC was actually involved in the change or whether it was done by the RFK Junior HHS which oversees the CDC Many at CDC were surprised I spoke with several scientists at CDC yesterday and none were aware of this change in content said Dr Debra Houry who was part of a group of CDC top officials who resigned from the agency in August When scientists are cut out of scientific reviews then inaccurate and ideologic information results The updated page does not cite any new research It instead argues that past studies supporting a link have been ignored by health authorities A number of former CDC officials have said that what CDC posts about certain subjects including vaccine safety can no longer be trusted Dr Daniel Jernigan who also resigned from the agency in August told reporters Wednesday that Kennedy seems to be going from evidence based decision making to decision based evidence making US Sen Bill Cassidy a Louisiana Republican earlier this year played a decisive role in approving the RFK Junior nomination for HHS secretary Cassidy initially voiced misgivings about Kennedy but in February said Kennedy had pledged not to remove language from the CDC website pointing out that vaccines do not cause autism The new site continues to have a headline that says Vaccines do not cause autism but HHS officials put an asterisk next to it A note at the bottom of the page says the phrasing has not been removed due to an agreement with the chair of the US Senate Health Education Labor and Pensions Committee that it would remain on the CDC website

Speaking outside the US Capitol in Washington, DC flanked by Democratic members of Congress including Representatives Eugene Vindman of Virginia and Jamie Raskin of Maryland, Hanan Elatr Khashoggi said she is seeking the help of the lawmakers to get the contents of the conversation between President Trump and MBS to get the truth Try as much as you can to save the democratic freedom of America Khashoggi implored the audience at the gathering Do not be a copy of the Middle East dictator countries We look to America as our role model of modern civilization Please maintain it Vindman urged the declassification and

release of what he called a highly disturbing 2019 call between Trump and MBS who US intelligence agencies say ordered the Khashoggi murder the contents of which the congressman claimed would shock people if they knew what was said At the time of the call Vindman was serving as a lawyer on the Trump National Security Council where his duties included reviewing presidential communications with foreign leaders All week I have urged the president to release this transcript Vindman said during his remarks at the Friday press conference Yesterday, I sent him a letter with 37 of my colleagues demanding its release We will continue pressing until the American people get the truth Given the Trump disturbing and counterfactual defense of Saudi Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman this week I felt compelled to speak up on behalf of the Khashoggi family and the country I serve he added On Tuesday, Trump warmly welcomed the crown prince to the White House calling him a respected man designating Saudi Arabia a major non NATO ally and announcing the planned sale of F35 fighter jets to the kingdom Trump also threatened an ABC News reporter who attempted to ask MBS about his role in the Khashoggi murder calling the victim somebody that was extremely controversial and whom a lot of people did not like Whether you like him or did not like him things happen Trump said as MBS smugly looked on dubiously adding that the crown prince knew nothing about it Responding to the Trump comments the widow of Khashoggi said that there is no justification to kidnap Khashoggi torture him to kill him and to cut him to pieces This is a terrorist act," she added Trump has sought closer ties to Saudi Arabia during his second term as he courts up to 1 trillion dollars in investments from the kingdom The New York Times reported Monday that the Trump Organization which is run by the two eldest sons of Trump is in talks that could bring a Trump branded property to Saudi Arabia raising concerns about possible corruption and conflicts of interest
