2 Brazil Stopping the Greatest Threat to the Amazon One Fire at a Time After four decades of research a scientist returns to the Amazon in an effort to change the behavior that has led to years of environmental crisis **RAWSEP View** The fact that burning of wood emits 90 percent PM 2 point 5 particulate matter of 2 point 5 micrometers the perfect size to infiltrate the human lung setting off a cascade of human health problems and early deaths is not mentioned in this article Burning of any wood whether in Amazon farm fields or forests or indoor residential wood burning also produces CO2 which hastens climate change Also not mentioned in this article is that PM 2 point 5 also hastens climate change **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501 C3 nonprofit organization** The New York Times November 22 2025 A researcher first set fire to the Amazon rainforest in 1985 After years of experiments including numerous attempts to intentionally light the Amazon aflame he arrived at a surprising conclusion Forests are pretty hard to burn down Much has changed since then As climate change has pushed global temperatures to record levels the Amazon has become increasingly combustible creating years of rolling environmental crisis On top of that **the vast majority of fires in the Amazon are set by humans particularly by farmers clearing land for agriculture** Fire begets fire In 2025 a record amount of tropical primary forests burned around the globe

according to the World Economic Forum five times as much as the 2024 level of forest loss. In the Amazon fires consumed an area larger than California. Now the researcher is returning to the Amazon to try to stop fires in a region that scientists have identified as a critical bulwark against global warming. Fire is the biggest threat to the Amazon but it is also a problem that is possible to solve. This is the biggest climate solution that could happen over the next few years. Working through his own nonprofit organization the **Earth Innovation Institute** along with a coalition of other groups local business leaders and international research groups **the researcher is trying to encourage small shifts in behavior that might help stop fires before they begin**. The changes he is asking farmers to make can be modest planting different crops letting forests return and pooling resources to afford machinery that can clear land instead of resorting to intentional burns. Yet in the aggregate he believes these modifications can have a major effect. On a recent weekend ahead of **his participation COP30** the United Nations climate summit in Belém Brazil the tropical ecologist returned to Paragominas the city where he began his research 41 years ago. He and his team spent days traveling to remote farms with just a few dozen head of cattle and to large ranches with thousands of cows **explaining how different farming practices could reduce the risk of fire and help land be more resilient when flames arrive**. Fires in Brazil have grown worse in recent years. Last year they swept across the Pantanal the largest wetlands in the world. After seasonal rains failed to materialize last year a record number of fires charred the Amazon. Five years earlier in 2019 another bad fire season consumed vast tracts of land. When agricultural land burns it affects the livelihoods of the more than 40 million people who live in the Amazon. **The fires also release vast quantities of stored carbon dioxide into the atmosphere accelerating global warming**. This marks a stark reversal of an age old trend. In recent centuries the Amazon acted like a filter absorbing many of the planet warming emissions from the burning of fossil fuels like coal oil and gas. But some of this area is no longer a reliable carbon sink. In recent years parts of the Amazon that have been developed into farmland including the area where the researcher started his career now produce more carbon dioxide than they absorb. Left unchecked scientists warn that the loss of Amazon to fire and deforestation could lead to irreversible changes leading to much of the forest giving way to grasslands and further accelerating global temperature rise.

At the request of Donald Trump Republicans called a special legislative session and carved out the Kansas City congressional district of longtime **Democratic representative Emanuel Cleaver** and replaced it with a Republican one. It was part of a nationwide push by Trump to get about half a dozen states controlled by Republicans at the state level to rejigger maps to find more GOP seats ahead of the 2026 midterms. But Missouri offers something distinct. A chance for voters to rebuke politicians and stop the map from going into effect. A provision added to the Missouri constitution in 1908 allows voters to pause most enacted laws from going into effect and put them up for a

referendum if voters gather enough signatures Since 1908 Missouri voters have used the citizens veto process about two dozen or around 24 times in 117 years In nearly every case voters have chosen to repeal the statute they have been asked to vote on The Missouri legislature approved the map in the middle of September and Governor Mike Kehoe, a Republican, signed it into law at the end of the September The woman and her husband and canvassers across Missouri have until December 11 2025 to turn in more than 106 thousand signatures that must come from six of the eight congressional districts of Missouri If they can the new map will be on hold until voters decide whether to adopt it in a 2026 referendum Canvassers say they have already collected more than 200 thousand signatures and say they plan to turn in more We turn in signatures the map goes on hold said the executive director of **People not Politicians** the group leading the signature gathering effort The Missouri effort is being closely watched amid a middle of the decade redistricting war between Democrats and Republicans that will shape which party controls the US House of Representatives Republicans currently have a three seat majority that is as thin as a razor but have redrawn congressional districts in Missouri Texas and North Carolina to add as many as seven seats **Breaking News is that The Texas map was recently struck down by a three-judge panel but the US supreme court temporarily halted the ruling on Friday November 21 2025 while an appeal is pending** Democrats are poised to counter those gains with their own redrawn maps in California and Virginia Recognizing the huge consequences of the Missouri effort outside groups have poured money into the campaign Committees on both sides have raised about 7 million dollars which includes funds from national Republicans opposing the effort Recognizing the likelihood of the new map being blocked Republicans have launched a great effort to halt the referendum Missouri secretary of state Denny Hoskins a Republican, is trying to get more than 90 thousand signatures thrown out A group funded by the Republican National Committee recently sent out a text message encouraging people to withdraw their signatures on the petitions The Missouri attorney general has also filed a separate lawsuit based on a fringe legal theory arguing that the state legislature has the exclusive power to draw congressional districts so it cannot be overturned through a citizens veto A shadowy group has offered canvassers 5 thousand dollars to stop collecting signatures **RAWSEP View** Offering voters money to stop collecting signatures **reminds RAWSEP** of the effort of Elon Musk to offer potential voters the chance of winning money if potential voters signed a petition and attended a Republican rally held before the Spring 2025 Supreme Court Race in Wisconsin **RAWSEP View** AI Overview In the Wisconsin Supreme Court race in spring 2025 Elon Musk and his affiliated groups significantly contributed to the campaign of conservative candidate Brad Schimel The Musk political action committee America PAC was the largest donor, contributing over 12 million dollars to the Schimel campaign Additionally the Musk organization Building Americas Future contributed nearly 6 million dollars The race has become the most expensive judicial contest in US history with total spending nearing 100 million dollars The Musk involvement underscores his political influence and his support for Schimel who is backed by Trump and other Republican figures In spring 2025 Elon Musk offered potential voters in Wisconsin a chance to win 1 million dollar checks by signing a petition opposing activist judges The offer was part of a campaign to influence the outcome of the Wisconsin Supreme Court race which was pivotal for the control of the judiciary in the state of Wisconsin The petition did not name any candidates on the Wisconsin ballot and the offer was made to voters who had already signed the petition This initiative was part of a broader strategy to sway voter opinions and influence the election results
