The editor of RAWSEP has consulted no statistics on whether those who prefer heating their homes through the primitive method of wood burning also prefer cooking over that same wood stove

Could it take the women telling the men they share a household with that **We are not buying any more wood for your air polluting wood stove?** Could it take the women telling the men they share a household with that **We are going to get rid of your air polluting wood stove?** Or are the men themselves in those households because it is after all enlightened 2025 **open to the idea that the method of home heating they chose in the past is air polluting** and heightens the risk of disease and early deaths for **themselves their families** and their near neighbors as well as contributing to hastening climate change without any women in the household having to say **We Are Not Buying It?** Can the men themselves who appear to the editor of RAWSEP based on the methods of advertising to their base by the Wood Burning Industry to be the majority of those who buy and stock and use wood burning stoves **understand that wood stoves create health and life denying**

air pollution? Can the men themselves understand that Heat Pumps that work down to 40 degrees below zero and double as air conditioners are within their economic reach because US Federal Heat Pump rebates of up to 8 thousand dollars based on a sliding income scale are available at least until the end of 2025? Can the men themselves understand that US states are stepping up to offer their own Heat Pump rebates that extend beyond 2025? Can the men themselves understand that there are still tax incentives to use clean methods of home heating extending past 2025? Or will advertising by the Wood Stove Industry continue to compel men and women alike to buy wood for burning and buy and use wood stoves despite overwhelming scientific and medical evidence that by doing so they imperil the health and lives of their families and themselves as well as their near neighbors and cumulatively the world? To counter Wood Stove Industry advertising the argument could be made that to be a real man in the opinion of the Editor of RAWSEP you protect your family from harm What are the inconvenient facts about Wood Burning? The EcoDesign wood stove the cleanest burning wood stove in the United Kingdom emits emit 2 point 8 times the PM 2 point 5 and CO2 pollution as coal burning The EcoDesign wood stove the cleanest burning wood stove in the United Kingdom emits emit 450 times the PM 2 point 5 pollution as natural gas burning PM 2 point 5 particulate matter of 2 point 5 micrometer size is the perfect size to infiltrate the human lung setting off a cascade of human health problems and early deaths

Even if venting directs air pollution outside the house the air pollution travels to the yards and infiltrates the homes of near neighbors of an indoor residential wood burner PM 2 point 5 also hastens climate change and CO2 from wood burning also hastens climate change If in fact the editor of RAWSEP is wrong in her assumptions about wood stove use by men and women above and an equal or more percentage of women compared to men burn wood for home heating or cooking the editor makes an additional rash assumption that some women and perhaps an equal number of men choose have and use a wood burning stove or a wood burning fireplace because of the aesthetics The editor of RAWSEP can point to an actual statistic to base this assumption on In London England a study showed that wood burning appliances were used inside homes by the wealthy more often than not and not for economic reasons but more often than not primarily for aesthetics As a solution to the problem of most indoor residential wood burning the editor of RAWSEP suggests ditching the wood stove or blocking the chimney of the fireplace to keep out vermin and retain heat from new modern methods of home heating such as Heat Pumps The editor of RAWSEP suggests converting the firebox to a place for a salt water aquarium for seahorses The possibilities are endless but if the mantelpiece of a fireplace is retained it could keep its aesthetically pleasing spot in the home as a place to hang a flat screen TV above for example without danger of melting the TV Or a former firebox could be converted to a bookshelf a place for toys for children et cetera Or a flat screen TV in the fire chamber itself could play visions of horribly air polluting house fires continuously to provide the desired ambience and aesthetics A disused firebox could project Halloween like graphics aesthetically Halloween resembling when a wood fire in actuality gets out of control inside a house continuing to burn wood Excerpts edited by RAWSEP

Government Efficiency a group that **slashed through government programs and fired civil servants** In response protesters organized Tesla Takedowns gathering at Tesla dealerships to urge people not to buy the vehicles The protests spread internationally In March Trump advertised Teslas on the South Lawn of the White House to try to help **slumping sales** to no avail In September **consumers flexed their muscle** over parent company the Disney suspension of the Jimmy Kimmel late night talk show on ABC after pressure from Federal Communications Commission chair Brendan Carr over the Kimmel comments following the murder of right wing activist Charlie Kirk About three million subscribers canceled Disney plus in September while Hulu which Disney owns lost 4 point 1 million Monthly cancellations previously had averaged 1 point 2 million and 1 point 9 million respectively While not all of those cancellations could be chalked up to consumer anger over the Kimmel suspension **Disney subscription prices went up at around the same time Kimmel was back on the air in five days** In the late 1800s to recreate a web of social responsibility in the growing industrial cities young middle class women moved into ethnic working class neighborhoods to minister to the people living there Jane Addams who opened the Hull House in Chicago in 1889 **rejected the idea of a nation divided by haves and have nots** She believed that all individuals were fundamentally interconnected Hull House was soberly opened on the theory that **the dependence of classes on each other is reciprocal** Addams later wrote The people who lived in these settlement houses dedicated themselves to filing down the sharp edges of industrialization with its tenement housing low wages long hours child labor and **disease along with polluted air and water** and unregulated food Today the relationship between consumption and reform has taken on **heightened meaning after the Tesla and the Disney boycotts** The day after Thanksgiving is the start of the holiday shopping season and like their predecessors of a century ago reformers are focusing on the power of consumers to push back on the policies of the Trump administration launching a campaign they call **We Aint Buying It**

**Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** The Guardian November 26 2025 The Wisconsin elected supreme court issued two orders on Tuesday **appointing a pair of three judge panels to hear two lawsuits** that argue the battleground Wisconsin congressional maps must be **redrawn before the 2026 elections** because **they unconstitutionally favor Republicans** The two lawsuits filed in July by liberal law firms come after failed attempts to redraw the Wisconsin congressional districts which are **currently skewed in favor of Republicans** so that the closely divided state is currently represented in Congress by six Republicans and just two Democrats The minority conservative justices of the court criticized the creation of the three judge panels as a partisan ploy designed to benefit Democrats **It is unclear whether new districts could be ordered in time for the 2026 midterms as some Democrats want** Both of the pending redistricting cases in Wisconsin argue that the Wisconsin congressional maps first adopted in 2011 are an **unconstitutional gerrymander favoring Republicans** Law firms that brought the pending cases in Wisconsin had argued over objections from Republicans that **the cases should be heard by three judge panels as required under a 2011 law passed by a Republican controlled legislature and signed by a Republican governor Scott Walker** Any decisions by those panels can be **appealed to**

the Wisconsin supreme court which is now controlled 4 3 by justices elected with the support of Democrats
