1 Centers for Disease Control Data Why CDC health data are still reliable even amid challenges to communications and integrity **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** Your Local Epidemiologist Newsletter December 10 2025 Back in February a lifetime ago when data were being edited under Executive Orders and all CDC communications were effectively frozen I outlined four scenarios that would signal real cause for concern about CDC information Two of them have now unfolded in the past month The breach of scientific integrity for example the autism and vaccines site along with other less publicized changes The injection of political messaging into HHS channels Never did I think I would see it but here we are The full extent of the damage is still unclear and how much more may occur remains unknown But one question stands out what is the integrity of the data itself? Public health data the public information used to estimate disease hospitalization and death rates for example are a vital resource Their value lies in their purity reliability accuracy and accessibility Despite everything I remain confident in CDC data This largely stems from the system of the US public health unconventional decentralized structure A fragmented system for epidemiologists but one that now works to our advantage You had six top questions **1** Why can we still trust CDC data? The key is a nuance most people find boring **Public health data in the US do not flow from the top down data are decentralized and built from the bottom up** Local and state health departments and hospital systems collect manage clean and report data before they ever reach CDC Take flu data When someone is hospitalized the hospital records the case That information moves to local or state health departments where teams verify and clean it Only then do states upload finalized numbers to CDC through secure systems CDC then stitches these local puzzle pieces into a coherent national picture This role is essential because diseases do not respect state lines CDC data inform cross state responses hospital capacity planning testing needs resource allocation early warning signals and shared lessons across jurisdictions Without CDC we would have 50 separate snapshots instead of a unified national system Because CDC primarily stitches data rather than collects it federal interference is much harder CDC does run direct data collection for vital statistics and surveys including collecting information on vaccination uptake mortality and health behaviors such as smoking and nutrition Most of these datasets remain intact with exceptions some data elements have been removed like transgender status and funding cuts may halt certain surveys **2** What about states that may also want to interfere with data? **For many diseases reporting is legally required by states** A classic example is measles when a patient is diagnosed the health care provider must report the case to the county or state health department But states voluntarily share this information with CDC If a state wants to stop reporting to CDC for whatever reason and for whatever data

they have the authority to do so We saw this challenge during COVID 19 when some states like Texas stopped reporting vaccination data after the emergency period ended The result was a significant gap on the CDC dashboard leaving an incomplete national picture This year you could easily see a potential flip scenario some states could choose to stop reporting to CDC because of a lack of trust in HHS 3 Is automation helping detect outbreaks in this moment of strain? What about layoffs **Yes! Automation is incredibly helpful for outbreaks but humans do the work too** When someone is diagnosed with a foodborne illness for example the testing lab typically sends the bacterial isolate to the state public health lab The samples are genetically sequenced and results are uploaded to PulseNet CDC database Then algorithms scan for genetic clusters on data from across the country The core of outbreak response still relies on human investigation interviewing patients tracing food histories and linking cases to a source The more cuts we have to staff the more limited our capacity will be to respond to some of these outbreaks Many are **bracing for next year when budgets will be cut by billions** 4 Have data communications changed? Collecting data is one thing Communicating it is another **Communications capacity has been dramatically reduced** The National Public Health Coalition a grassroots organization of fired HHS employees found the Office of Communications is operating at roughly half of its pre October capacity Source CDC Data Project As you can imagine this impacts outputs Take Health Alert Network HAN these are safety alerts sent to physicians as a heads up on what to look for when there is an emerging issue The HAN office still exists but it takes significant initiative to complete a HAN even when the administration cares about such matters **HAN has published only five alerts since the new administration took office** For comparison HAN published 16 alerts in 2024 and 18 in 2023 5 Is there a world where a US based NGO gets created to effectively replace the CDC? To some extent this is already happening as quickly as possible We see this from multiple angles **Regional coalitions sharing communications briefs and insights** **Groups not part of the Federal Government synthesizing data like the Vaccine Integrity Project** **Communication efforts including professional organizations like AAP who has STEPPED UP on social media platforms and grassroots efforts like The Evidence Collective** **Data democratization efforts like Pop HIVE** The problem is that nothing can ever compete with the far reaching infrastructure and authority of the budget of the federal government 6 What does this mean for you? You can feel confident that CDC data are accurately tracking diseases And if you are data gurus like us you can also feel confident using the CDC data We will let you know when our confidence decreases But also keep in mind that other sources exist **Local and state public health departments** remain primary sources of data often publishing their own dashboards **Data sources which are not Federal such as WastewaterSCAN Biobot and PopHIVE** provide additional datasets Bottom line The data infrastructure is largely intact thanks to a decentralized system As a nation we will need to continuously ensure this is the case as data are gold The communications capacity however has been severely weakened Americans should not have to monitor inputs and outputs from the leading public health agency in the nation but **here we are** Love YLE

2 RFK Junior expands baseless Covid Vaccine safety inquiry Washington DC Food and Drug Administration FDA Expands Covid Vaccine Inquiry to Adult Deaths The agency under RFK Junior claimed that 10 deaths of children were linked to the shots although it did not release evidence to support the assertions **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** The New York Times December 9 2025 The Food and Drug Administration has expanded its investigation of deaths possibly linked to the Covid vaccine to include adults as well as children according to a Trump administration official The inquiry began in September spurred by Health Secretary the RFK Junior repeated claims that the coronavirus vaccine is dangerous and deadly despite the widespread scientific consensus that the shots are safe At the time the agency said that it was looking into deaths of children in apparent response to the vocal concerns of vaccine skeptics who are allies and supporters of RFK Junior Former agency officials have said that they did not ignore concerns about the Covid vaccine They said they had reviewed reports of childhood deaths filed with the agency by examining autopsy reports and medical records To the best we could see these vaccines were not associated with the deaths of children Doctor Peter Marks the CDC former top vaccine regulator said in September when news of the review first came out Is it possible that a death could

have occurred that was related to the vaccines? Yes I guess possible Some adult deaths related to Covid vaccines were widely known including at least three attributed to a rare blood clotting complication from the Johnson & Johnson vaccine Federal authorities initially paused and later stopped use of that vaccine in the United States Among the broader changes sought by Doctor Prasad is a halt to updating well tested vaccines to match circulating strains of viruses like the flu without time consuming studies Such a requirement could make such vaccines obsolete before they are approved After the Doctor Prasad memo emerged 12 former FDA commissioners published an article in the medical journal NEJM saying the changes undermine the public interest They are the latest in a series of troubling changes at the FDA including substantial departures of FDA staff that could diminish both the strength of the FDA and the health and safety of Americans the 12 former commissioners wrote It remains unclear whether the agency will formalize the proposed changes into regulations or a guidance the way it typically describes such changes to pharmaceutical makers

3 RFK Junior expands baseless RSV Vaccine safety inquiry Washington DC Food and Drug Administration FDA US health officials examine RSV shots again despite documented safety and efficacy The FDA is reviewing RSV vaccines which have drastically lowered infant hospitalizations a spokesperson confirmed Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization The Guardian December 10 2025 US regulatory officials are examining the safety of RSV shots again despite no published reports of safety issues a move that could lead to the removal or limitation of shots that have dramatically lowered hospitalizations among babies It is the latest move from US health officials under RFK Junior the secretary of the US Department of Health and Human Services HHS and a longtime anti vaccine activist to limit access to shots and to undermine public trust in the safe and effective products Officials at the US Food and Drug Administration FDA told three manufacturers of RSV preventative treatments for babies last week their products are being reviewed because of safety concerns raised by activists against vaccines The RSV shots were the first time we had any kind of tools to prevent these complications said Elias Kass a naturopathic physician specializing in pediatrics in Seattle Washington RSV was the most common cause of hospitalization among US infants he added To have a tool to prevent that is incredible There were two working groups assessing evidence on RSV for the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices ACIP to the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention CDC One group focused on the vaccines given during pregnancy and the other on the preventative shots given to babies No new safety information about RSV shots has been released In fact news from the group was positive The shots to prevent RSV are one of the greatest public health breakthroughs in recent years with dramatic declines in hospitalization Vaccinating during pregnancy was 55 percent to 68 percent effective in keeping newborns from being hospitalized in the first six months of their lives according to a survey of studies published in the New England Journal of Medicine in October Babies who were given the preventative antibody shots were 79 percent to 83 percent less likely to be hospitalized the study found Decisions from the FDA could limit access to the shots and public health experts worry that the announcements without evidence undermining the shots could affect public trust and confidence in vaccine safety Before the shots were widely available 2 percent to 3 percent of all infants in the US were hospitalized for RSV The respiratory illness has also been associated with developing asthma Almost every parent has some experience with RSV So I think it is going to be a lot easier to talk about the risk and benefits of these interventions to parents just because they realize what a devastating disease it is

5 Massachusetts US judge strikes down Trump order blocking wind energy projects Federal judge declared January executive order unlawful ruling in favor of a coalition of state attorneys general

Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization The Guardian December 9 2025 A federal judge on Monday struck down the Trump executive order blocking wind energy projects saying the effort to halt virtually all leasing of windfarms on federal lands and waters was arbitrary and capricious and violated US law A Judge of the US district court for the district of Massachusetts vacated the Trump January 20 2025 executive order blocking wind energy projects and declared it unlawful The woman judge ruled in favor of a coalition of state attorneys general from 17 states and Washington DC led by Letitia James the New York attorney general that challenged the Trump day one order that paused leasing and permitting for wind energy projects See a related article titled The Trump hatred for renewables means the US is falling behind the rest of the world! Trump has been hostile to renewable energy particularly offshore wind and prioritizes fossil fuels to produce electricity The woman Massachusetts attorney general hailed the ruling as a victory for green jobs and renewable energy Massachusetts has invested hundreds of millions of dollars into offshore wind and today we successfully protected those important investments from the Trump unlawful order the Massachusetts Attorney General said in a statement She said she was grateful the court stepped in to block the Trump reckless and unlawful crusade against clean energy As New Yorkers face rising energy costs we need more energy sources not fewer she said Wind energy is good for our environment our economy and our communities The coalition that opposed The Trump order argued that Trump does not have the authority to halt project permitting and that doing so jeopardizes the economies energy mix public health and climate goals of US states The coalition includes Arizona California Colorado Connecticut Delaware Illinois Maine Maryland Massachusetts Michigan Minnesota New Jersey New Mexico New York Oregon Rhode Island Washington state and Washington DC They say they have invested hundreds of millions of dollars collectively to develop wind energy and even more on upgrading transmission lines to bring wind energy to the electrical grid The judge allowed the states to proceed with claims that blocking permits for wind energy projects violates the Administrative Procedure Act which outlines a detailed process for enacting regulations but not the constitution Wind is the largest source of renewable energy in the United States providing about 10 percent of the electricity generated in the nation according to the American Clean Power Association The executive director of the Alliance for Clean Energy New York said wind energy is a key component of powering the electric grid of the nation Wind is currently one of the most cost effective ways to generate power and is being used successfully not only in the United States but across the world she said With this ruling behind us projects can now be judged on their merits We thank the attorneys general who helped us get this case over the finish line A representative of the Natural Resources Defense Council called the decision a win for consumers union workers US businesses clean air and the climate From the beginning of its time in office the Trump administration put a halt to the wind energy projects that are needed to keep utility bills in check and the grid reliable The wind order has been a devastating blow to workers electricity customers and the reliability of the power grid she said adding that the Trump administration should use this ruling as a wakeup call stop its illegal actions and get out of the way of the expansion of renewable energy

her Democratic party leaders and is all but certain to fail Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization The New York Times December 10 2025 Representative Haley Stevens of Michigan a Democrat running for Senate filed articles of impeachment on Wednesday against Health Secretary RFK Junior making an all but certainly futile bid to charge him with undermining public health diminishing decades of scientific and medical progress and imperiling the health of the American people In accusing RFK Junior of an assault on the public health system that constitutes high crimes and misdemeanors Ms Stevens said the secretary had delayed biomedical innovation through the far reaching and haphazard termination of working scientists She cited the RFK Junior cancellation of 8 point 9 billion dollars in federal research grants and said he was chilling medical innovation including lifesaving clinical research in what amounted to a violation of his oath of office With Republicans in control of Congress it would be close to impossible for the articles of impeachment of Ms Stevens to get a vote on the House floor or lead to a trial in the Senate And though Ms Stevens said she had discussed her impeachment push with Representative Hakeem Jeffries of New York the minority leader Democratic leaders are not backing it Ms Stevens is a centrist Democrat who may see a political upside in taking on the mantle of impeachment while running for Senate Her Democratic opponents Mallory McMorrow and Abdul El Sayed have been generating enthusiasm and keeping pace with Ms Stevens in terms of fundraising Ms Stevens said noted that she often heard from Republican doctors whose work was being affected by the RFK Junior actions RFK Junior is carrying out a scientific coup day état of American public health and his conduct warrants impeachment Ms Stevens wrote in a letter to her colleagues She added RFK Junior represents the single largest self-created threat to public health public trust and the future of scientific progress in the United States If we do not act Americans will suffer The secretary must go

producer of oil and gas in the world should be studied The Trump administration has made American energy dominance the core of its economic strategy **Solar geoengineering offers a way to manage temperature risk without loosening the grip of the carbon economy** Controlling both the energy supply of the world and the global thermostat has obvious appeal to the White House and its **billionaire backers** The call from the African governments for **an agreement to not use solar geoengineering echoing the precedents of landmine and chemical weapons bans** is a recognition that some technologies shift power so sharply that they create **unmanageable risks** A line has to be drawn The precautionary principle is used with other novel technologies Why not here?
