**2** Trump 12 billion to farmers does not undo tariffs damage US farmers say the Trump 12 billion dollar package not enough to undo damage from tariffs Thousands of farms set to go bankrupt as grain farmers in particular hit by trade disruptions caused by price hikes **RAWSEP View** The biofuel solution will increase air pollution Wind and Solar and Geothermal are renewables that are clean energy with no added air polluting emissions Biofuels are technically renewable but they create air polluting emissions of PM2 point 5 and CO2 as indoor residential wood burning industrial wood burning and the choice of farmers to burn field stubble instead of recycling also create unnecessary air pollution at a time when clean renewable energy such as wind and solar is cheaper to produce and therefore cheaper for consumers **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** The New York Times December 22 2025 Donald Trump having promised to NEVER LET OUR FARMERS DOWN appeared to come through for them this month when he unveiled a 12 billion dollar aid package Industry leaders say thousands of farms will still go bust this year While the US president has vowed to increase domestic farm production and even claimed this formed a big part of his plan to lower grocery prices for Americans many US farmers are grappling with mounting financial issues compounded by the Trump agenda Grain farmers in particular have been hit by trade disruptions caused by tariff hikes and 11 billion dollars of the US Department of Agriculture Farmer Bridge Assistance Program will go to row crop farmers The Trump trade war with China has hit soya bean farmers the hardest as China bought 54 percent of US soya bean exports last year according to the American Soybean Association But the one time payments do little to assuage the financial stressors that row crop farmers have faced for the past three years because of rising input costs and lower crop prices This year alone US crop farmers have lost 34 point 6 billion dollars before crop insurance and other government support according to the American Farm Bureau Neither row crop nor specialty producers who raise fruits and vegetables made money in 2025 and the 2026 outlooks are bleak While federal aid was welcomed the president of the Arkansas Farm Bureau said it falls short of what is needed He said A program that provides roughly 50 dollars an acre will not save the thousands of family farms that will go bankrupt before the end of the year The Environmental Protection Agency is expected to announce an increase in the total renewable fuel requirements for 2026 and 2027 The key piece to the new rules will be biomass based diesel production blending requirements Farmers

are expecting a significant increase in production under the new guidelines which could help offset some of the export market losses

By the time we got there he had gone from peaky to barely responsive Had we missed Christmas? Although our friend eventually recovered he had actually punctured a lung And while that Christmas is not a personal favorite it has gone down in family lore as the Christmas I saved a life Whether that is strictly true or a little bit of dramatic license I could not possibly comment but its annual retelling certainly has not hurt my ego And as our friend always says do not let the truth get in the way of a good story

Ukrainians in Poland face growing resentment Change in attitudes has been stoked by disinformation viral videos and the election of rightwing populist president **Excerpts edited by RAWSEP for brevity and clarity and relationship to Residents Against Wood Smoke Emission Particulates a 501C3 nonprofit organization** The Guardian December 22 2025 A Ukraine born woman was out buying ice cream with her husband and four year old daughter when a man overheard them speaking Ukrainian Teach your daughter to speak Polish said the stranger Then he physically assaulted both parents The incident which happened in the city of Szczecin in north west Poland reflects an increasingly hostile atmosphere for Ukrainians in the country a dramatic turnaround from the mood in 2022 In the aftermath of Russian full scale invasion hundreds of thousands of Poles put on a show of support and hospitality for their neighbors volunteering at the border and offering up their homes to refugees Now that outpouring of goodwill is wearing thin as the war approaches its fourth anniversary and surveys show an increasingly negative perception of Ukrainians in Poland stoked by a political debate that has moved further to the right on migration and the resurfacing of historical grievances A sports hall of Hrubieszow Poland that was transformed into an accommodation facility for refugees fleeing the Russian invasion Ukraine in March 2022 There are about a million Ukrainian refugees in Poland according to UNHCR statistics from September The woman who was assaulted in 2025 is not one of them she is one of nearly half a million Ukrainians in the country who arrived prior to 2022 and has lived in Poland for more than a decade I am more Polish than Ukrainian now but I never thought someone would lecture me on how to talk to my own family she said Since the assault she has panic attacks and has told her daughter to never speak Ukrainian in public Her experience was extreme and the attacker ended up being sentenced to 14 months in prison but the experience of receiving abuse for speaking Ukrainian in public has become widespread Discrimination is not universally felt particularly among those who

live in bigger cities A 39 year old woman a child psychologist from the city of Kryvyi Rih moved to Warsaw with her two children in the summer of 2023 after deciding that her home city which is subjected to regular Russian attacks was becoming too scary a place to raise her children She chose Warsaw because her niece had already moved there Since then she has learned Polish through government sponsored language courses retrained as a massage therapist and recently opened her own salon in central Warsaw Personally I have had nothing but good experiences in Poland she said When her children now 10 and 15 started school in Warsaw the teachers and other parents went out of their way to be helpful she said At one evening of parents everyone was asking how they could help It almost brought me to tears she said The only negativity she has experienced has been online Whenever she opens Facebook or other social media she is bombarded with negative comments about Ukrainians I have just started not to look any more she said The 39 year old woman said that while many of her Ukrainian friends have started to leave citing the changed atmosphere and increasing cost of living she now hopes to make a future in Poland I think it would be better for my children and give them more opportunities than going back home she said
