In 1945, she witnessed the liberation of Dachau, leaving just days before Germany's unconditional surrender. What she saw in Dachau taught her more about the reality of evil. "A darkness entered my spirit," Gellhorn told a friend. She would later describe Dachau as the moment and an emotional end when she stopped being young.
