for Americans said shots against polio and measles and perhaps all diseases should be optional offered only
in consultation with a clinician Doctor Kirk Milhoan a pediatric cardiologist who is chair of the Advisory
Committee on Immunization Practices said that he did have concerns that some children might die of
measles or become paralyzed with polio as a result of a choice not to vaccinate But he said I also am
saddened when people die of alcoholic diseases adding Freedom of choice and bad health outcomes In the
case of an infectious disease a personal choice to decline a vaccine may also affect others including infants
who are too young to be vaccinated or people who are immunocompromised But the right of a person to
reject a vaccine supersedes those risks Doctor Milhoan said If there is no choice then informed consent is
an illusion he said Without consent it is medical battery The polio and measles vaccines are widely
acknowledged as staggering successes in public health credited with preventing disability and millions of
deaths worldwide The polio vaccine in particular has strong bipartisan support including from President
Trump and some Republican lawmakers who have invoked the horrific time before the vaccine was available
But Doctor Milhoan said that making the vaccines optional rather than requiring them for entry into public

schools nationwide as is now the case would ultimately restore trust in public health. Outside experts had sharp words for Doctor Milhoan saying the changes in vaccine policy he was suggesting would result in unnecessary deaths among children. He has no idea what he is talking about said Doctor Sean O Leary chair of the infectious disease committee at the American Academy of Pediatrics. These vaccines protect children and save lives. Doctor O Leary said: "It is very frustrating for those of us who spend our careers trying to do what we can to improve the health of children to see harm coming to children because of an ideological agenda not grounded in science." Doctor Milhoan outlined some of his views in an episode of the podcast "Why Should I Trust You?" that aired on Thursday. In the podcast he said: "polio and measles were not the threat they once were in the United States because of improvements in medicine and sanitation" rather than the vaccines alone echoing comments by Health Secretary RFK Junior. He described himself as pulling back the curtain on the risks of vaccines. In a series of text messages later on Thursday and Friday he elaborated on his view that "personal autonomy was paramount." The vaccine committee may not necessarily recommend that all vaccines be optional he added but it is charged with reevaluating all of the vaccine products including risks and benefits and "may make significant changes to the roster of childhood vaccines over the coming year." Any changes the committee makes would add to a significant reshaping of the vaccination schedule announced this month by federal health officials. Bypassing the process that the committee has long followed for vaccine recommendations "Mister Kennedy and his appointees debuted a schedule that reduces the number of recommended immunizations to 11 from 17" and "advises that the six vaccines that were dropped should now be administered only under shared clinical decision making that is after consultation with a health care provider." A spokesman for the Department of Health and Human Services declined to comment on the views of Doctor Milhoan. "So far states and insurance companies are continuing to follow the previous vaccination schedule which is still endorsed by the American Academy of Pediatrics and other medical organizations. All 50 states and the District of Columbia require children to be vaccinated against most of the 17 diseases to attend public schools." Children can be exempted from the shots for medical or other reasons. Still "requiring routine shots for school entry is heavy handed and authoritarian." Doctor Milhoan said on the podcast: "What we are doing is returning individual autonomy to the first order not public health but individual autonomy to the first order" he added. A vaccine expert and previous member of the committee said Doctor Milhoan seemed to misunderstand the purpose of the vaccine committee. "A CIP makes recommendations for what is best for the whole population" Doctor Brewer said. "As for individual autonomy all vaccines are already delivered with patient consent" he noted. "For me autonomy means being able to have my children go to the grocery store or go to preschool and not be stalked by a vaccine preventable disease that will kill them."

Pollsters found that 65 percent of respondents believe climate change is contributing to rising costs at least a little. This includes 88 percent of liberal Democrats and 77 percent of moderate or conservative Republicans. Forty nine percent polled said they think policies promoting clean energy will improve economic growth and provide new jobs. I find it stunning that even some

people in the climate community say that we should stop talking about the climate because there is a cost of living crisis going on said the Yale Program on Climate Change Communication Director. It is a fundamental error to treat these issues as mutually exclusive; climate solutions are also cost of living solutions. Most of the elite discourse is very bad at estimating or understanding levels of public concern and this is a good example of this. The Yale poll found that majorities of voters also favored reentering the Paris Climate Agreement using more renewable energy and using fewer fossil fuels. President Trump has long cast doubt on the science behind climate change and his administration has sought to rollback efforts to mitigate global warming. The polling came prior to the directive from the Trump National Science Foundation to break up the National Center for Atmospheric Research in Boulder, Colorado. The Trump White House Office of Management and Budget Director Russell Vought called the facility one of the largest sources of climate alarmism in the country. A Rutgers University professor said axing the climate research will weaken the weather forecasting ability of America. The Yale survey was conducted November 6 to 14, 2025 and included 1,466 respondents with a margin of error of 3 percentage points.

In the summer of 2022 Democrats in Congress were racing to pass the biggest climate law in the history of America and President Biden was declaring that global warming posed a clear and present danger to the United States. But behind the scenes four Trump administration veterans were plotting to obliterate federal climate efforts once Republicans regained control in Washington. Two of them Russell T. Vought and Jeffrey B. Clark were high profile allies of Donald Trump. Mister Vought who has railed against climate alarmism and Mister Clark who has called climate rules a Lenin-like **plot to seize control of the economy** drafted executive orders for the next Republican president to dismantle climate initiatives. The other two Mandy Gunasekara and Jonathan Brightbill were lesser known conservative attorneys with long histories of fighting climate initiatives. Ukraine routinely strikes Russian military facilities as well as oil infrastructure that helps Russia finance its war and supply the Russian army with weapons fuel and equipment. Ukraine targeted a Russian drone warehouse in the city of Rostov on Don located in Rostov Oblast destroying three containers filled with FPV drones and their components according to the report. The General Staff added that several additional containers were damaged but did not provide further details. Ukrainian forces also struck a command post of airborne troops from Russia in the city of Sudzha Kursk Oblast as well as a Russian ammunition depot near the village of Novooleksiivka in the Russian occupied part of Kherson Oblast. The scale of Russian military losses and the full extent of the damage are still being assessed the General Staff said.
