15 states sue RFK Junior organization over Vaccine Schedule Revisions

The plaintiffs in the new lawsuit include the attorney general of Wisconsin

The 14 attorney generals are from Arizona, California, Connecticut, Colorado, Delaware, Maine, Maryland, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, New Mexico,

Oregon, Rhode Island and Wisconsin, as well as Governor Josh Shapiro

of Pennsylvania. The suit names the Department of Health and Human Services

and Robert F. Kennedy Junior as defendants. It also names the Centers for Disease

Control and Prevention and its acting director, Doctor Jay Bhattacharya. RFK Junior

and his C.D.C. are flouting decades of scientific research, ignoring credible medical

experts, and threatening to strain state resources and make children of America

sicker," Rob Bonta, attorney general of California, said, "vaccines save lives of children

and save our state's money," "Also, without copying Denmark's health care system

Copying Denmark's vaccine schedule doesn't give families more options. Left are

kids unprotected from serious diseases," said Kris Mayes, Arizona attorney general there.

The lawsuit asks the courts to nullify the January 2026 Trump administration decision

to reduce the number of diseases children are routinely immunized against from 17 to 11.

It also challenges "the unlawful replacement" of members of the federal administration

Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices, who recommend vaccines for Americans.

The lawsuit by Democratic states is similar to one filed in July by six medical organizations

including the American Academy of Pediatrics. The Health Department was sued by organizations

of physician and medical personnel after Kennedy announced on social media that

Covid vaccines would no longer be recommended for healthy children or women that

are pregnant. They, too, argued that Kennedy and his appointees have made "arbitrary

and capricious" changes to the childhood vaccine schedule, bypassing carefully

reviewing evidence over months or years before making new recommendations.

The top staff of HHS and the CDC are now unqualified and without medical reputations

Use of scientific and medical knowledge, data and research is the usual practice.

RFK Junior has no medical or science degrees and Casey Means MD has no license to practice.

Both RFK Junior and Means are against vaccines and if Casey Means becomes Surgeon General
