RFK Junior Vaccine Policies were struck down by a Federal Judge
On March 16 2026 and this invalidates the RFK antivaccine lunge
Which threatened public health since confirmation in February 2025
The lawsuit which the judge ruled on today was filed in July 2025
by 6 medical organizations notably the American Academy of Pediatrics,
after RFK Junior announced on social media that Covid vaccines in a manic
statement would no longer be recommended for healthy children
or pregnant women. Covid 19 Vaccines saved lives of many humans
during the last pandemic. RFK Junior seemed a threat to human health
in the eyes of medical professionals. RFK Junior with no stealth
eating roadkill carcasses and snorting coke from a toilet seat
illustrating even if he is rapidly aging human health is not his priority
The medical organizations asked the court to restore the immunization
schedule from a year ago, before RFK Junior began making revisions.
The ruling also reversed, at least for the time being, all decisions
made by the panelists of the Advisory Committee for Immunization
Practices or A C I P that RFK Junior appointed. The vaccine panel's chair,
a pediatric cardiologist, suggested in February 2026 that all vaccines for
childhood, including the shots against polio and measles, should be optional
because the diseases no longer pose the dangers they once did, an irrational
position most public health experts immediately denounced as dangerous.
Other A C I P members suggested, contrary to the scientific consensus,
that Covid shots are deadly and should be taken off the market . Allowing panelists
to make decisions about vaccines is Nationally dangerous and "just as reckless
as letting a group of amateur pilots dictate how our airplanes should fly,"
by denying Covid shots on which most Americans for their health rely
In June, RFK Junior fired all 17 previous members of the vaccine committee
and selected new panelists, most of whom shared his skepticism of vaccines
and mandates. In three meetings since then, the panelists rescinded several
recommendations for childhood shots, including the immunization of all
newborns against hepatitis B, an infectious virus that can severely damage the liver.
Separately, Jim O'Neill, whom RFK Junior installed as the CDC's acting director
at the time, announced a new schedule for childhood vaccines in January rescinded
recommendations for some shots, effectively the number of diseases amended
to 11 from 17 the vaccines children are routinely immunized against. 6 organizations
asked the court to restore the earlier immunization schedule, before RFK Junior revisions
began. The goal is "to stop dangerous vaccine policies and to restore science
to our nation's vaccine decision making," After the decision medicine with science.
The Judge agreed with the 6 medical organizations that RFK Junior appointee changes
were "arbitrary and capricious" changes to the childhood vaccine schedule, ranged
from bypassing the careful, evidence-based practice with past reliance on clean
scientific and medical recommendations to attacking the lifesaving COVID vaccine.
