World War Two make ex-soldiers nostalgic for the explosions

Of smoke and fire they experienced when abroad in Europe?

The same lobbyist states "Over Fifty Percent of all homes in the USA

have fireplaces. Statistics say that Fifty Eight Percent of hearth owners

consider their fireplace, wood or pellet stove or insert to be a major design

feature in their home." Near neighbors say, " Just because it can be a design

feature does not mean buyers requested that design feature. Maybe they

would rather spend their money on a home feature that instead keeps them

healthy and does not contribute To climate change. Climate Change hastens

floods, hail, and searing outdoor heat and most crucially does not create conditions

in the home or vented outside into the yards and infiltrating the homes
of near neighbors that resemble the PM Two Point Five particulate air pollution
Of wildfire burning that we are experiencing now and experienced
To a less extent in Two Thousand Twenty Three from Canadian wildfires.

What are the glaring drawbacks to fireplaces that lobbyists try to address?

If you do use a wood burner or open fire for heating,

it will only provide warmth in the room it's in

Modern appliances, radiators, and central heating

have replaced the functional benefits of a fireplace.

The oldest arrangement was a central fire and a central roof opening

the first central home heating system. They channeled hot air from

a furnace through pipes placed behind walls and under floors.

Lobbyists say "In Two Thousand Twenty Five, we saw an emphasis on statement
surrounds that turn functional fireplaces into works of art."

These require a chimney. Any home with a gas water heater or gas furnace

of less than Ninety Five Percent efficiency also requires a chimney.

Near Neighbors reply. "Why not have actual works of art displayed in your home,

Such as paintings and statues that will only be exposed to grime

If a wood burning appliance like a wood burning stove or a fireplace

Is used, and exposes the family members to life shortening air pollution?
